PARISH MEMBERSHIP

To be considered an active member of Christ the King Parish, each family and single adult must:

- ⇒ BE PROPERLY REGISTERED
- ⇒ ATTEND SUNDAY MASS AT OUR CHURCH
- ⇒ REGULARLY USE OUR WEEKLY ENVELOPES

This is the only way that the parish can issue documents that attest to parish membership and Catholic practice (EG. A Sponsor Certificate for a Godparent/Confirmation Sponsor).

New parishioners are invited to register by email or in person at the Rectory office.

VISITS TO THE SICK & HOMEBOUND

During the pandemic, a Home Visit can only be arranged in emergency cases (risk of death).

Catholics who are in hospitals, nursing homes, etc. will be attended by the assigned chaplain at their location - parish priests are not permitted to visit.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Preliminary arrangements should be made at least one year prior to the proposed date of marriage. One of the parties must be a registered member of our parish and speak with a parish priest to enroll both in the required marriage preparatory courses and book the date of their wedding.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Registration for Baptism takes place by meeting with a priest. The child's Birth Certificate is needed at the time of registration. Godparents must each present a Sponsor Certificate, signed by a priest of the Church they attend, stating that they are currently practicing Catholics and meet all Sponsor Requirements:

- ⇒ AGE 16 OR OLDER
- ⇒ CONFIRMED
- ⇒ MARRIED IN THE CHURCH (if married)
- ⇒ CONSISTENTLY ATTENDING MASS (Sundays/Holydays)

Baptism dates cannot be scheduled until the SPONSOR CERTIFICATES are handed in. Parents and Godparents must attend one instructional class.

Parents must be registered parishioners of Christ the King Church.

A Note from Father Probbins...

Dear Friends in Christ,

I would like to say "thank you" to one and all for the very warm welcome that you have given me! So many of you have said, "thanks for coming to us." Let me, then, extend to you the same greeting: "thanks for letting me come to you." This is, definitely, a match made in heaven.

Quite a few have inquired about Fr. Staar, our pastor emeritus. He is doing well under the circumstances. I know that he is grateful for your continuing love and prayers.

I have come to realize that there are a number of "projects" that need to be tackled in order of priority. I have had some meetings and can assure you that you should be able to see some progress in the coming weeks.

- 1. There are three trees which are a present danger to the stability of the rectory. We are getting bids on their removal and it should happen sooner rather than later. (If there is anyone who has old photos of the rectory, I would be grateful to see them or to have copies made. I am told that the rectory could be as old as the late 1800's and was probably of a "salt box" design.)
- 2. The church building, itself, is in need of a new roof and attention must be paid to the wood shingling on the sides. While it is always treacherous to promise too much, too soon, I have hope that both projects will be tackled this summer.
- 3. The wheelchair access ramp to the church is a complicated situation. For every inch of elevation needed for the ramp, we need a foot in length. This will require some serious planning since we will need to redirect the direction of the incline. I understand how this is a priority and we will move prudently and in complete observance of the ADA requirements.

Enough for now. Fr. Staar's long illness may have slowed down some of the momentum but with the good weather months ahead of us, we will begin to move. Of course, thanks for your generosity which will make this all possible!
