"God never dies" (Luke 20:27-39)

The great Mexican singer-songwriter, Pedro Infante, composed the beautiful song "God never dies". In its first verses he says: "The sun dies in the mountains with the light that is dying because life in its haste leads us to die... But it does not matter knowing that we will have the same end because we have the consolation that God will never die". Although in a different context, but no less conflictive for that, and two thousand years ago Jesus gave us the same hope by proclaiming that "he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive". We are called to life and our actions manifest the goodness of a God who does not want us crying incessantly.

Some are saddened as days grow shorter, leaves fall from trees, and the last of the year's crops are harvested, and the Church calls to mind those who have died and Jesus' promise of eternal life. However, Jesus proclaims the resurrection of the dead when the religious authorities of his own time refused to accept it. May our faith in Jesus, dead and risen, give us hope in these dark days of November that we have just begun.

The story of the 7 Maccabean brothers and their mother who were arrested and tortured because of their faith is a reminder that faith in eternal life becomes a force more powerful than suffering and death. Many Mexican brothers who also died because of their faith while crying "Viva Cristo Rey" promoted the construction of a magnificent monument on the top of the Cubilete mountain. This Christ of the Mountain was described by another Mexican author as "consolation of those who suffer and veneration of the people"...

The faith in eternal life that Jesus speaks to us about led his disciples to leave all their possessions behind to follow him. He told each disciple to take up his/her own cross and follow him. This is what Jesus tells us today to you and me. Let us ask for the strength of a faith that moves mountains and console ourselves with the faith that proclaims our eternal life. Let us live faithfully adhering to his mandates and pray not to fall into temptation. Our faith tells us that death is not the end. This same faith is what motivates us to resist even in the midst of suffering and despair. The 7 Maccabean brothers and the 7 brothers in today's Gospel have something in common: they all appeared to have died in vain. I say apparently, since despite giving their lives one after another and leaving no descendants, we know that they did not die since they live in the memory of their people. Jesus said it well: "God is not God of the dead but of the living" (Luke 20:38). May our consolation not be to live in the memory of our descendants but that we are forever held in God's infinite memory.

The Torch has the sacred intention of the union of all the peoples of America, since Our Lady of Guadalupe is considered the "Queen of the Americas." This practice is specifically associated with the Guadalupe devotion. It is said that when Juan Diego appeared before the bishop to deliver the request of the Virgin of Guadalupe for a shrine on the Tepeyac hill and spilled roses at her feet, the torchbearers carried the news of the miraculous apparition throughout the country.

NOVEMBER: THE MONTH OF ALL SOULS IN PURGATORY: SEVEN DAYS OF PRAYER FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY

PREPARATORY PRAYER (to be prayed each day at the beginning of the Novena)

My Jesus, by the sorrows You suffered in Your agony in the Garden, in Your scourging and crowning with thorns, in Your journey to Calvary, in Your crucifixion and death, have mercy on the souls in purgatory, and especially on those that are most forsaken; deliver them from the torments that they endure; call them and admit them to Your most sweet embrace in paradise, where You live with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. *Amen*. (Continue by saying the daily prayer below on each appointed day)

SUNDAY - O Lord God Almighty, I beseech You by the Precious Blood which Your Divine Son Jesus shed in the Garden, deliver the souls in purgatory, and especially that one which is the most forsaken of all, and bring it into Your glory, where it may praise and bless You forever. *Amen.* (Our Father, Hail Mary, Eternal rest, Ending Prayer)

MONDAY - O Lord God Almighty, I beseech You by the Precious Blood which Your Divine Son Jesus shed in His cruel scourging, deliver the souls in purgatory, and among them all, especially any soul which is nearest to its entrance into Your glory, that it may soon begin to praise You and bless You forever. *Amen*. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Eternal rest, Ending Prayer)

TUESDAY - O Lord God Almighty, I beseech You by the Precious Blood of Your Divine Son Jesus that was shed in His bitter crowning with thorns, deliver the souls in purgatory, and among them all, particularly that soul which is in the greatest need of our prayers, in order that it may not long be delayed in praising You in Your glory and blessing You forever. *Amen.* (Our Father, Hail Mary, Eternal rest, Ending Prayer)

WEDNESDAY - O Lord God Almighty, I beseech You by the Precious Blood of Your Divine Son Jesus that was shed in the streets of Jerusalem while He carried on His sacred shoulders the heavy burden of the Cross, deliver the souls in purgatory and especially that one which is richest in merits in Your sight, so that, having soon attained the high place in glory to which it is destined, it may praise You triumphantly and bless You forever. *Amen*. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Eternal rest, Ending Prayer)

THURSDAY - O Lord God Almighty, I beseech You by the Precious Body and Blood of Your Divine Son Jesus, which He Himself on the night before His Passion gave as meat and drink to His beloved Apostles and bequeathed to His Holy Church to be the perpetual Sacrifice and life-giving nourishment of His faithful people, deliver the souls in purgatory, but most of all, that soul which was most devoted to this Mystery of infinite love, in order that it may praise You therefore, together with Your divine Son and the Holy Spirit in Your glory forever. *Amen.* (Our Father, Hail Mary, Eternal rest, Ending Prayer)

FRIDAY - O Lord God Almighty, I beseech You by the Precious Blood which Jesus Your Divine Son did shed upon the tree of the Cross, especially from His sacred Hands and Feet, deliver the souls in purgatory, and particularly that soul for whom I am most bound to pray, in order that I may not be the cause which hinders You from admitting it quickly to the possession of Your glory where it may praise You and bless You for evermore. *Amen.* (Our Father, Hail Mary, Eternal rest, Ending Prayer)

SATURDAY - O Lord God Almighty, I beseech You by the Precious Blood which gushed forth from the sacred side of Your Divine Son Jesus in the presence and to the great sorrow of His most Holy Mother, deliver the souls in purgatory and among them all especially that soul which has been most devout to this noble Lady, that it may come quickly into Your glory, there to praise You in her, and her in You through all the ages. *Amen.* (Our Father, Hail Mary, Eternal rest, Ending Prayer)

OUR FATHER: Our Father, Who art in heaven; hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
