MARY MOTHER OF GOD **NEW YEAR 2023**

"Mary kept thinking about all this and wondering what it meant" (Luke 2:16-21)

Happy New Year!

Not long ago I was listening to an old song called Hymn of my Heart. Immediately came to mind the thought of what should be the ideal start to this new year because "life is a useful book for those who can understand..." How appropriate it is for us to think like this on the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. Mary is

a hymn of love of someone who with obedience to the Word of God becomes an active participant in the plan of redemption.

Without letting go of the desire to be good at the end of the year, today we are beginning this 2023 filled with hope that this will be a better year. The popular saying goes "new year, new life"." Once again the hymn mentioned above inspires us to live with the "confidence in life". In fact, those are the same feelings of Aaron and his descendants. The Chosen People were looking forward to a new beginning in the promised land. Aaron and his children implored blessings, grace and peace upon them. Shephers, beyond their human limitations, realized that a new beginning was taking place in Bethlehem and hurried there to see the newborn king. Mary, the young maiden, embraces the beginning of her new life as a mother, as she

keeps thinking about all this and wondering what it means. So, with the same attitude of the mother of God, we can start this new year with the confidence that God is on our side because he became incarnate, he became one of us, so that we can also be children of God.

The shepherds are Jesus' first evangelizers, proclaiming the good news of great joy. Ironically, the first people they tell are Mary and Joseph themselves, who already know the good news from the angel's visit. The Birth of Jesus that we have just celebrated becomes joy for all who listen to it and is once again the center of the message in this octave of Christmas in which our world celebrates the beginning of this new year 2023.

Reflection is a habit we seem to have lost in today's world. However, the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God helps us to meditate on being God's children and therefore brothers and sisters in a world that seeks peace for all. Starting a new year calls us to the solidarity of the one who, being omnipotent, was incarnated in a small child. May Jesus, Prince of Peace, Son of Mary and our brother be an inspiration for all of us to live as brothers and sisters and to work for peace. Let's each begin to write the "Hymn of my Heart" and be that useful book so that others can understand.
