SHORT CATECHISM OF MARY

Mary, Our Mother according to Grace **35. Can we compare Eve and Mary?**

Yes. EVE, who listened to the devil and disobeyed God, and the greatest part after Adam in bringing about the misery of all human beings. Mary, who listened to the angel and obeyed God, had the greatest part after Jesus in bringing about the salvation of all human beings. St. Irenaeus wrote around the year 200: "just as eve, having Adam a spouse but still a virgin, was through her disobediance the cause of death for herself and the whole human race, so Mary, destined for a spouse but still a virgin, was through her obedience the cause of salvation for herself and the whole human race." Tertullian wrote around 210: "Eve believed the serpent and Mary believed Gabriel; where the credulity of Eve results in sin, the faith of Mary results in reparations."

36 Who willed that the Blessed Virgin should have so great a part in the salvation of human beings?

Jesus. It was He who willed to await the response of the Blessed Virgin to the Angel before coming to earth to save human beings.

Mary Gives us Jesus, Source of Grace 37. When did the Blessed Virgin become for the first time the Mother of all human beings in the order of grace?

At the Annunciation, when she became the Mother of Jesus, Author and Source of grace for all human beings.

38. Did the Blessed Virgin already have a great love for all human beings?

Yes. She was happy to know that Jesus would come to save human beings from their sins (Matthew 1:21), and she was ready to suffer much for our salvation (Luke 2:35).

Mary Coredemptrix

39. After the birth of Jesus, did the Blessed Virgin still do very great things for the salvation of human beings?

Yes. She united herself with all the sufferings of Jesus during His life and during His Death.

40. When did the Blessed Virgin become for the second time the Mother of all human beings in the order of grace?

On Calvary, when she prayed that the sacrifice of Jesus might bring grace to all human beings.

41. At the moment, did Jesus think of the great suffering of His Mother?

Yes. He thought of the great suffering of His Mother and He united them to those that He Himself endured to save us.
