SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

-Group Baptisms are offered on the first and third Sundays of each month. Arrangements must be made by contacting the Rectory. Godparents are required to be practicing Catholics, attending Mass regularly. First time parents must meet with a priest for instruction. All paperwork and payment (including sponsor certificates) are due at least 1 full week before the baptism.



-Matrimony arrangements should be made at least <u>8</u> <u>months</u> prior to wedding date. Couples must attend designated Marriage Preparation Courses. Couples must meet with the parish priest before a wedding date can be scheduled. We do not celebrate Weddings on Sundays.



My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.


I love you above all things and I desire to receive you in my soul.







IRS RULES FOR RCC CONTRIBUTIONS

*Tax day has been extended until July 15th, this means that you do not have to file your tax return by April 15th and you will not be charged any penalties or interest if you file on or before July 15th.

Donors are advised NOT to file their federal income tax return before they receive their contribution summary from the Church. Donors may not be able to deduct individual contributions of \$250 or more if they file a tax return before receiving a contribution summary from their Church. ON PARADISE


