SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

-Arrangements for all Baptisms must be made by contacting the Rectory. Godparents are required to be practicing Catholics, attending Mass regularly. First time parents must meet with a priest for instruction. All paperwork and payment (including sponsor certificates) are due at least 1 full week before the baptism.



-Matrimony arrangements should be made at least $\underline{\mathbf{8}}$ **months** prior to the wedding date. Couples must attend designated Marriage Preparation Courses. Couples must meet with the parish priest before a wedding date can be scheduled. We do not celebrate weddings on Sundays.



SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Sponsor Certificates are signed and sealed documents attesting to the fact that you are a **practicing Catholic** (going to Mass every week and living the Catholic faith). A Sponsor Certificate is required if you are being asked to be a sponsor for Confirmation or a godparent for Baptism. Please do not be offended if you can not receive a Sponsor Certificate because you are not living up to the requirements of being a sponsor.


