LENTEN DISCUSSION GROUP

"The Search" is a multi-part video based spiritual experience from the producers of the **FORMED** online platform many of us use for faith formation at our parishes. The well-known Catholic evangelist Chris Stefanick hosts *"The Search"*. However, *"The Search"* is not meant just to be watched and it is certainly not meant to be watched alone.

That is why the parishes of **St. Gregory and St. Vito/Most Holy Trinity** are invited to begin to form virtual small groups to watch, discuss and truly benefit and grow from experiencing *"The Search"* during our Lenten season. If you have not done so already, sign up for **FORMED** at www.formed.org (**FREE OF CHARGE**). Then, sign up as a parishioner, (When asked for the name of the parish, type in the zip code, 10543.) Then click on St. Vito/MHT. Create an account by typing your name and email. Scroll down to *"The Search"*.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday, February 17th,
we ask you to watch **Episode 1,**
"What Do You Seek?"

There will be two opportunities to join in our small group discussions on the video, one group will meet virtually on **Thursdays at 1:00 pm**, and the other on **Mondays at 7:00 pm**. There will be a new episode to watch for each of the weeks of Lent. The first virtual group discussion will be on **February 18th and February 22nd** respectively. Please sign up for only one discussion group as space is limited. "A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said:

'If you wish you can make me clean.' Moved with pity he stretched out his hand, touched him and said to him, 'I do will it. Be made clean...' The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean... The man went away and began to publicize the whole matter. He spread the report abroad so that it was impossible for Jesus to enter a town openly." This week we will begin the Season of Lent. To prepare myself well, may I find that I too am a leper, needing cleansing, healing and new spiritual strength. Consider for a moment the pandemic, now one year old, affecting millions, taking countless lives. The search for a cure, vaccines, the use of masks, distancing and hand washing became a new practice for all. Yet the scars remain. Our spiritual lives are suffering too. Have I looked at the health of my soul and see the need for cleansing and renewal? Am I ready to tell the Lord today: 'Here I am, how do you find me?' This is my opportunity to be honest with myself and the Lord, to act, ask for forgiveness, to begin a time of prayer, to say thanks to the Lord for a good confession, to admit to my need to learn the mercy of Jesus. The miracle for the leper, 'If you wish', is mine today, and Jesus, with the same pity as He looks at our corona virus affected world, wishes to help us.

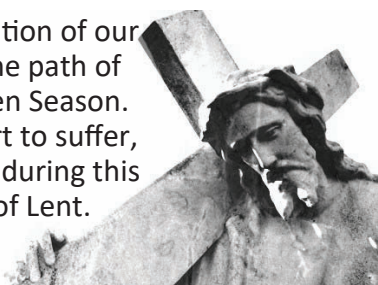

Please follow the directions of the Mass celebrant regarding the receiving of Ashes.

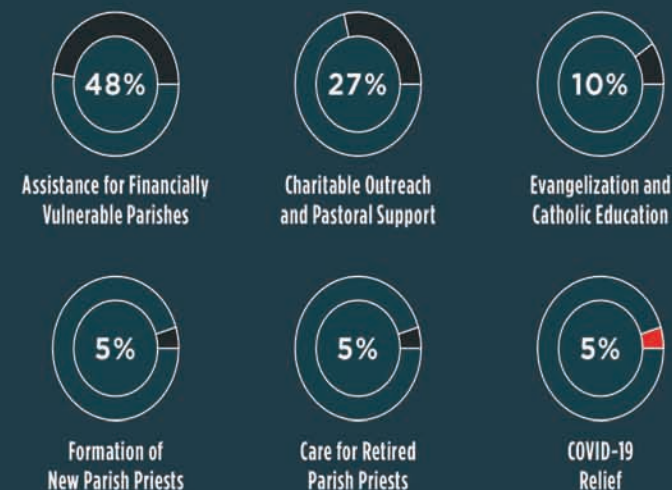

Il profeta Isaia proclamava

che il Messia sarebbe venuto per annunciare la buona novella ai poveri. Gesù, commentando questo testo nella sinagoga di Nazaret, dice solennemente: "Questa parola della Scrittura... si adempie oggi". Ma Gesù è venuto per guarire le malattie dei poveri, spesso in modo straordinario o prodigioso? Certo Gesù dà spesso prova della sua misericordia di fronte alle sofferenze umane. Ma, in ogni caso, questi sono segni del potere che il Figlio dell'uomo ha ricevuto da colui che lo ha mandato per liberare da una schiavitù più profonda, da una lebbra più cronica, per liberare dal peccato. Chi può perdonare i peccati, se non Dio? "Ora, perché sappiate che il Figlio dell'uomo ha il potere in terra di rimettere i peccati: alzati disse al paralitico, prendi il tuo letto e va' a casa tua". Cos'ha Gesù, che cosa irradia il Maestro per provocare nel lebbroso questa supplica colma di fiducia: "Se vuoi, puoi guarirmi"? Gesù si avvicina al lebbroso: "Lo toccò"; il lebbroso manifesta la sua fiducia, la sua gioia, la sua testimonianza, non può tacere. E noi? Noi siamo la Chiesa di Gesù che prolunga la sua presenza e la sua opera nel mondo. In tutti i settori dove è in gioco il dolore di un qualsiasi uomo, dove la sua dignità di figlio di Dio è in pericolo, dove c'è emarginazione, qualunque essa sia, là si gioca la nostra credibilità in quanto Chiesa che porta la salvezza di Gesù.

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“Se le acercó un leproso para pedirle ayuda y, cayendo de

rodillas, le dijo: ‘Si quieres, puedes purificarme.’ Jesús, conmovido, extendió la mano y lo tocó, diciendo: ‘Lo quiero, queda purificado.’ ... la lepra desapareció y quedó purificado. Apenas se fue, empezó a proclamarlo a todo el mundo, divulgando lo sucedido, de tal manera que Jesús ya no podía entrar públicamente en ninguna ciudad.” Esta semana comenzamos la Estación de Cuarema. Para prepararme bien, debo darme cuenta de que yo también soy un leproso que necesita limpieza, sanación y fuerza espiritual. Considere la pandemia por un momento, ha cumplido ya un año, ha afectado a millones y cobrado incontables vidas. La búsqueda de una cura, vacunas, el uso de mascarillas, el distanciamiento, lavado de manos se ha convertido en una nueva práctica para todos. Sin embargo las cicatrices permanecen. Nuestras vidas espirituales también sufren. ¿He notado la salud de mi alma y veo la necesidad de limpieza y renovación? Me pregunto si estoy listo a decirle al Señor hoy: ‘Estoy aquí, ¿cómo me encuentras?’ Esta es mi oportunidad de ser honesto conmigo mismo y con el Señor, a actuar, pedir perdón, comenzar un tiempo de oración, dar gracias al Señor por una buena confesión, a admitir mi necesidad de aprender la misericordia de Jesús. El milagro del leproso, ‘Si quieres’, es mío hoy, y Jesús, que con la misma piedad mira nuestro mundo afligido por el coronavirus, desea ayudarnos.

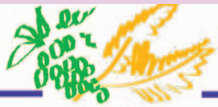

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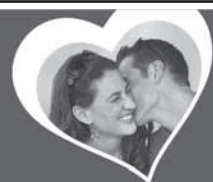
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
