





SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION (DECEMBER 9, 2024)

This year, December 8, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the womb of Saint Anne occurs on the Second Sunday of Advent. The Sunday of Advent takes precedence. But, because Our Lady under this title is the Patroness of the United States of America, observance of the Solemnity is transferred to Monday, December 9. The Pope's Prefect for the Dicastery on Legislative Texts has also recently clarified that the Holy Day of Obligation is transferred to December 9 this year. Therefore, so that parishioners can fulfill their obligation, Saint Peter's will have two Masses on Monday, December 9 at 12:00 Noon and 6:15 pm, respectively, at Our Lady of the Rosary Chapel. There will be no 8:30am Mass on Monday, Dec. 9, 2024.



STEPS TO PRAYING THE ROSARY




- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross and pray the "Apostles' Creed"
- 2. Pray the "Our Father"
- 3. Pray three "Hail Marys" for Faith, Hope, and Charity
- 4. Pray the "Glory Be"
- 5. Announce the First Mystery and then pray the "Our Father"
- 6. Pray ten "Hail Marys" while meditating on the Mystery
- 7. Pray the "Glory Be" followed by the "O My Jesus" Fatima prayer
- 8. Announce the Next Mystery; then pray the "Our Father" and repeat these steps (6 through 8) as you continue through the remaining Mysteries.
- 9. Pray the closing prayers: the "Hail Holy Queen," "Final Prayer," and "Sign of the Cross"

FREE TAX PREPARATION VOLUNTEERS NEEDED





December 8, 2024 Season of Advent

Dear friends in the Lord:

As we approach the annual collection for the *Retirement Fund for Religious* – an appeal that benefits nearly 25,000 elderly Catholic sisters, brothers, and religious order priests – I reflect on the ministry of women and men religious – past and present – and I am grateful for the ways they have shaped my own faith. I also value the tremendous service they have offered our archdiocese.

In their younger years, they laid the foundation for Catholic schools, parish religious education programs, hospitals, and works of mercy with very little compensation, leaving their religious communities with a shortage of retirement savings. Today, many serve in volunteer ministry. Others are frail and need assistance. Yet all remain committed to their vocations, accepting the limitations of aging and embracing the opportunity to spend more time praying for our Church and world.

Your gift, which will be collected on December 15, offers support that helps religious communities provide loving care for older members while ensuring younger ones can continue the good works of their elders. Rising health care costs and decreased income compound the challenge to meet day-to-day needs for medications, nursing assistance, and other necessities. Over 20 congregations in the archdiocese received more than \$2,000,000 in grants from this national collection.
