


## **CCD ROSARY**

#### **EUCHARISTIC DIALOGUE**

The Eucharistice Prayer is the center and summit of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. It begins with the preface dialogue between the presiding priest and the assembled people. The dialogue begins with the biblical greeting, "The Lord be with you." It is answered with "And with your spirit." Here, your spirit refers to the soul of the priest conformed to Christ the High Priest by the Holy Spirit at his ordination.

Next, the priest then invites us to raise our hearts, that is, the core of who we are in our spiritual soul, understanding mind, and loving will to God. We are created by God, reborn of God in Holy baptism, and want to be with God forever. Everything we have especially our existence already belong to God. Thus, we humble ourselves and put ourselves into God's hand. We try to banish all worldly and distracting thoughts since we all, as members of the Mystical Body of Christ, have a royal priesthood and thus a role in offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Finally, the word Eucharist means Thanksgiving. Jesus changed the Passover memorial, an act of thanksgiving, into the Thanksgiving of the New Covenant. The priest exhorts us to give thanks and we acknowledge that it is is befitting (dignum) and just (justum). St. Paul teaches us, "In all things give thanks" (1 Thess 5:18). We do this above all in the greatest of prayers.

Consider how fortunate you are to be a Christian and to be invited into this most solemn prayer. Scriptural verses reflecting the words of the dialogue are included for your meditation

The original Latin and Greek are also included because Latin is the official language of the Roman Church and Greek was the common liturgical language of the first century Christians.

### PRESENTATION ON THE WHOLE LIFE ETHIC

On Wednesday, May 28, at 7:00 P.M. at St. Joseph's Church in New Paltz (34 South Chestnut St.), we will host a round table discussion in the church hall with Destiny Herndon-De La Rosa, founder of the whole life ethic group "New Wave Feminists" based out of Dallas, TX. The whole life ethic is the belief that all human life, from conception to natural death, is inherently valuable and deserving of protection.

Currently, New Wave Feminists serves pregnant and parenting migrant mothers at two different shelters along the Texas/Mexico border. These homes, located in Juárez, Mexico and El Paso, Texas, offer safe havens where moms can continue their pregnancies free from any pressure to terminate, and also raise their already born children in a secure environment away from the violence and exploitation so many of them are fleeing. When she's not in Juarez, Destiny is speaking at colleges and helping pregnant moms in the U.S. by offering them practical support and alternatives to abortion.
