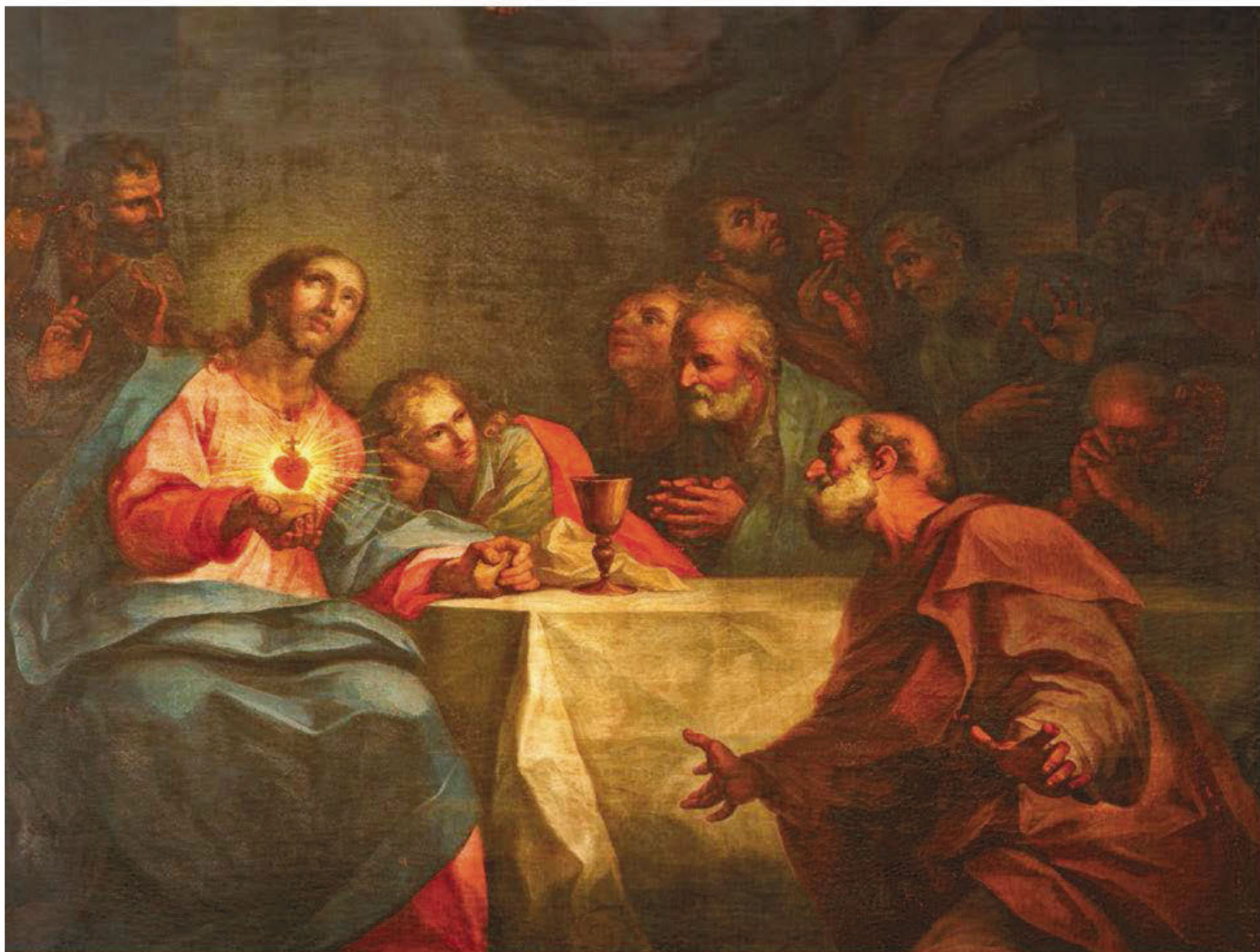

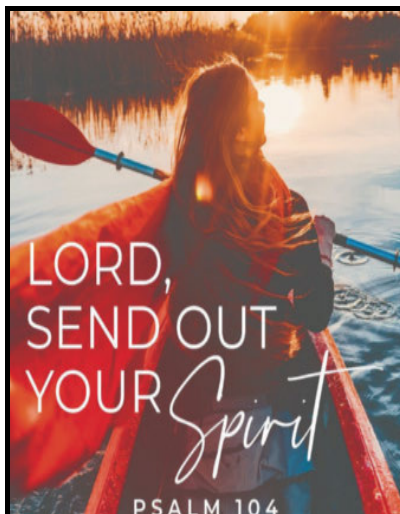

THE SANCTUS (HOLY, HOLY, HOLY)

The Preface of the Eucharistic Prayer ends with an invitation to join in the heavenly chorus of the angels and proceeds into the Sanctus, a hymn composed of verses from the Old and New Testaments. The Sanctus begins with the words heard by the Prophet Isaiah when he witnessed the six-winged Seraphim singing, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts. The entire earth is filled with His glory." The Roman text adds the word God, after the word Lord based on the vision of St. John recorded in Revelation 4. The word "hosts" can mean a number of things in English, but here translates the Hebrew "Sabaoth" which refers to armies.

Hosanna or "Hoshi'anah" is a Hebrew word and it is a joyful proclamation which literally means, "Save us, please." This was the cry of the people of Jerusalem when Jesus entered the city on what we call Palm Sunday. The cry is significant especially in light of what we are doing at Holy Mass. The Incarnate Son of God's Sacrifice on the Cross is the source of our salvation and becomes present in an unbloody manner at Holy Mass during the Eucharistic Prayer. And although we human beings are time bound, we seek to enter into Christ's eternal saving act by joining in the eternal praise of the heavenly chorus of angels.

The phrase, "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord," refers to Jesus in the past when the words were first spoken, in the present at Holy Mass when He comes to be really and truly present upon the altar, and in the future, when He will come again in glory.

The Sanctus was used in the liturgy of the city of Antioch where St. Peter was Pope from 42 to 49 AD and from there spread to Rome. One of the earliest mentions of it in writing is in St. Clement of Rome's (d. 100 AD) First Letter to the Corinthians.

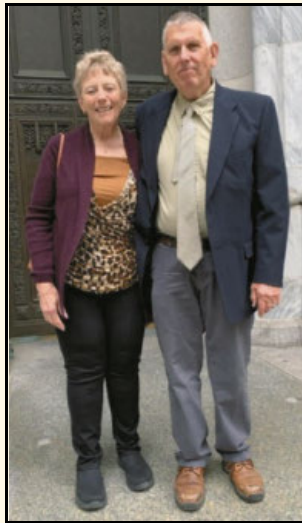

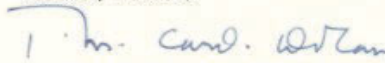

Four out of ten dioceses in the United States and its territories are considered "home mission" dioceses requiring outside financial help, with small Catholic populations, limited resources, vast and often difficult terrain, and a shortage of priests and religious. Despite the challenges, the communities continue to grow in faith to serve God and neighbor and form the next generation of faithful disciples.

I count on your usual generosity again and thank you for your donation of \$297,963 in 2024 which was divided equally between these two concerns. 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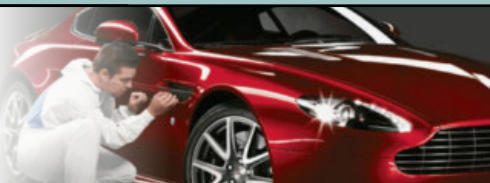
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
