INDULGENCES FOR ALL SOULS' WEEK AND NOVEMBER

<u>Visiting a Cemetery</u>: An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. Typically the indulgence is plenary each day from November 1-8; on other days of the year, it is only a partial indulgence.

<u>Visiting a Church on November 2</u>: A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who on the day dedicated to the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed [November 2 {as well as on the Sunday preceding or following, and on All Saints' Day}] piously visit a church. In visiting the church it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.



<u>Indulgence Requirements</u>: To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father while being detached from sin. It is appropriate that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgence work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgence act. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence.

The condition of praying for the intention of the Holy Father is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary. A plenary indulgence can be acquired only once in the course of the day.

To you, O Lord, we commend the soul of N. your servant; that having died to this world, he (she) live for You. And we beseech You that whatever sins he (she) committed through the frailty of the flesh during his (her) earthly life, You may in Your most tender mercy pardon and wipe away. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God, whose nature is always to forgive and to show mercy, we humbly implore You for Your servant N., whom You have called to journey to You, and, since he (she) hoped and believed in You, grant that he (she) may be led to our true homeland to delight in its everlasting joys. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.
