## **THE MOST REVEREND RONALD A. HICKS** **NEWLY APPOINTED ARCHBISHOP OF NEW YORK**

### **IMITATING CHRIST IN THE NEW YEAR**

CHRIST: Do not take it seriously, my child, if people think evil of you and say things about you that you do not want to hear. You ought to have a worse opinion of yourself and to think that no one is weaker than you are.

If you are well recollected within, you will take no notice of fleeting words from without. It is a sign of wisdom, when evil words are spoken, to keep silence and to turn your heart to Me, refusing to be disturbed by man's judgment.

Where will you find true peace and true glory if not in Me? Certainly this is so. The person who neither aspires to please others nor fears to displease them will enjoy much peace; for all disquiet of heart and distraction of the senses come from disorderly affections and groundless fear.

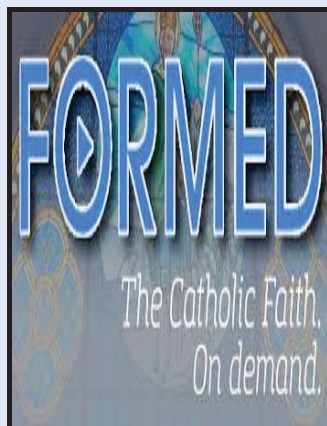
