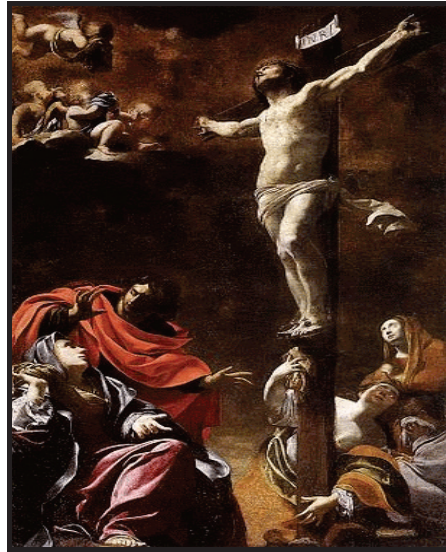

LENTEN RECIPES - PRUNE GNOCCHI

12 dried prunes, 2lb (1 kg) baking potatoes,
 2 1/2 cups (10 oz/315 g) all purpose (plain) flour,
 pinch of ground cloves, 1 egg, salt,
 3oz (90g) butter, 1 cup (2 oz/60 g) fresh breadcrumbs



Soak the prunes in lukewarm water, cover for 1 hour. Drain prunes, pit them and cut into small pieces. Set aside. Boil the potatoes in their skins until tender. Drain and peel them. Force through a sieve and mix with 2/3 of the flour, the egg and a pinch of salt. Knead the potato mixture well with floured hands. Form it into oval gnocchi about 1in (2.5cm) long. Insert a piece of prune into each and close the mixture over it. Arrange the gnocchi in rows on a floured board. Bring a large saucepan of salted water to boil. Cook the gnocchi a few at time, lifting them out with a slotted spoon as they rise to the surface. Arrange on a serving dish. Heat half the butter in a skillet. Fry the breadcrumbs with the cloves until they begin to color. Brown the remaining butter in a small skillet. Drizzle over the gnocchi, scatter with breadcrumbs and serve.

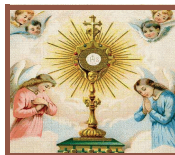

Dear Friends:

Each year, the Holy Father asks every Catholic parish to collect a Good Friday offering to assist *Christians in the Holy Land*, now less than 2% of the population, down 23% from a century ago. The collection supports the work of the Franciscans in the sacred shrines and parishes, provides formation and education in the communities and schools, and cares for the basic needs of the people there.

As you can imagine, hope is much needed for the *Christians of the Holy Land*. The tragic events that started on October 7, 2023, have brought many disastrous consequences, including a greatly increased need for support for the Christian community. TWELFTH STATION JESUS DIES ON THE CROSS St. Alphonsus Liguori

V. Adoramus te, Christe, et benedicimus tibi.
R. Quia per sanctam crucem tuam redemisti mundum.

V. We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You.
R. Because by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

Consider how your Jesus, after three hours of agony on the Cross, consumed at length with anguish, abandons Himself to the weight of His Body, bows His Head, and dies.

O my dead Jesus, moved intimately by a sense of piety, I kiss this Cross on which You, for my sake, fulfilled the goal of Your life. On account of the sins I have committed, I deserve to die an unhappy death; but Your death is my hope. By the merits of Your death, grant me, I pray, that I might be embracing Your feet, and burning with love for You, when I give up my last breath. Into Your hands I commend my spirit. I love You with my whole heart; I repent that I have offended You. Never permit me to offend You again. Give me perpetual love of You, and then make of me whatever might please You.

HOW TO MAKE A GOOD CONFESSION

Pray to the Holy Spirit for help to remember your sins AND to be sorry for them. Read through the items on this list below. If you committed a mortal sin (i.e. you know it was a big sin and chose to do it anyway), try to remember the number of times or, at least, the frequency (ex. a couple times a week over the past 2 months). Take this list to Confession to help you remember. Begin the confession by saying: "Bless me Father. I have sinned. (I am single/married.) It is (# days/weeks/months/years) since my last confession.

Venial sins are in lowercase letters: **venial**.

Venial sins that can become mortal sins are in bold letter: **venial or mortal**

Mortal sins are in capital letters: **MORTAL**

1. I am the LORD your God. You shall have no other gods before me.

Did I DENY I am Catholic?

Did I neglect prayer for a long time?

Did I WILLINGLY TAKE ACTIVE PART IN NON-CATHOLIC RELIGIOUS SERVICES, OCCULT THINGS (FORTUNE TELLERS, OUIJA BOARD), JOIN COMMUNIST PARTY OR FREE MASONS.

2. You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain.

Did I curse?

Did I curse using God's name?

DID I CURSE AT GOD?

Did I show disrespect to the saints or holy things?

3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day.

DID I MISS HOLY MASS ON SUNDAYS OR HOLY DAY THROUGH MY OWN FAULT?

Did I come late/leave early from Mass without a serious reason?

Did I work on Sundays for a LONG TIME without necessity?

DID I MAKE A BAD CONFESSION BY INTENTIONALLY NOT CONFESSING A MORTAL SIN?

DID I RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION OR ANOTHER SACRAMENT IN THE STATE OF MORTAL SIN?

DID I KNOWINGLY VIOLATE DAYS OF ABSTINENCE OR FAST; OR RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION WITHOUT FASTING FOR ONE HOUR?

DID I FULFILL MY EASTER DUTY?

6. You shall not commit adultery.

9. You shall not covet your neighbor's spouse.
DID I MARRY WITHOUT THE BLESSING OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH?

DID I ABANDON SPOUSE/FAMILY OR CAUSE A SEPARATION OR DIVORCE?

Did I refuse the marital act to my spouse without just reason or demand marital acts without concern for spouse?

DID I USE BIRTH CONTROL IN THE SACRED MARRIAGE ACT?

DID I USE IN VITRO FERTILIZATION OR ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION?

DID I STERILIZE MY SEX ORGANS FOR CONTRACEPTIVE PURPOSES?

DID I ENGAGE IN SEXUAL ACTS WITH SOMEONE WHO IS NOT MY SPOUSE

DID I TOUCH MYSELF WITH IMPURE INTENTION (MASTURBATION)?

DID I TOUCH SOMEONE ELSE'S PRIVATE PARTS?

DID I SEDUCE, DRESS IMMODESTLY, SEXUALLY HARASS?

DID I LOOK AT NAKED PEOPLE TO AROUSE SEXUAL PLEASURE?

DID I WILLFULLY ENTERTAIN IMPURE THOUGHTS?

DID I PURCHASE, VIEW, SELL, OR MAKE USE OF SEXUALLY AROUSING ITEMS?

WAS I IMPURE IN MY SPEECH?

Do I hang out with bad companions?

7. You shall not steal.

10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

Did I steal anything or help someone steal (what and how much)?

4. Honor your father and your mother. Did I disrespect or disobey the reasonable demands of my parents?

Did I ignore my parents in their old age or in their time of need?

Did I mock or make fun of old people? DID I NEGLECT TO EDUCATE CHILDREN IN THE PRACTICE OF THE CATHOLIC FAITH, PRAYER, (EX. PERIODIC CONFESSION, AND SUNDAY MASS)?

Do I intentionally break just laws?

5. You shall not murder.

DID I TO KNOWINGLY AND WILLINGLY CAUSE GRAVE BODILY HARM OR KILL AN INNOCENT HUMAN BEING?

WAS I INVOLVED IN AN ABORTION, THROUGH ADVICE, ENCOURAGEMENT, PAYING FOR ONE, ETC.?

DID I ASSIST IN, ATTEMPT, SERIOUSLY, OR CONSIDER SUICIDE OR EUTHANASIA?

Did I physically, verbally, or emotionally abuse another person?

Did I cultivate hate toward others?

Was I unfair or disrespectful to others because of the way they look?

DID I RISK MY OWN LIFE OR PUT ANOTHER PERSON'S LIFE IN DANGER? DID I GET DRUNK, USE DRUGS, OR GIVE DRUGS TO OTHERS?

DID I HELP ANOTHER TO COMMIT A MORTAL SIN THROUGH ADVICE, EXAMPLE, OR TAKING PART IN THEIR SIN?

Did I stoke my own anger or remain unwilling to forgive?

Did I seek revenge, or wish evil on others?

Was I cruel to animals cruelly?

Did I fight or quarrel?

Was I jealous or envious?

Did I intentionally destroy someone's property?

Did I keep valuable articles found?

Did I fail to contribute time, talents and money to support parish and Church? Did I waste money in gambling?

Did I cheat my employees of just pay?

Did I intentionally fail to give a full day's work for a full day's pay?

DID I FAIL TO HELP THOSE IN GRAVE AND IMMEDIATE NEED?

Did I fail to pay my debts?

8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Did I knowingly and willfully deceive another?

DID I LIE UNDER OATH (PERJURY)?

Did I telling the sins of another with no good reason (Detraction/libel)?

Did I tell lies in order to harm someone's reputation (Calumny)?

Did I assume the worst of another person without good evidence (Rash judgment)?

DID I WILLINGLY LISTEN TO A CONFESSION OR TELL OTHERS WHAT I HEARD?

DID I, THROUGH MY OWN FAULT, FAIL TO HONOR A CONTRACT OR TO PAY DEBTS?

If you did something and are not sure if it was a sin, ask the priest. After doing your best to confess remembered sins, end with, "I am sorry for these any sins I have forgotten." Then listen to any advice and the "penance" which the priests assigns. If you do not know what the penance is, tell him.

Act of Contrition: O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest all my sins because of Your just punishments, but most of all because they offend You, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

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
