Canon 867 §1.

Parents are *obliged* to take care that infants are *baptized in the first few weeks*; as soon as possible after the birth or even before it, they are to go to the pastor to request the sacrament for their child and to be prepared properly for it.

CONFIRMATION / CONFIRMACION

Elementary school students must be baptized and enrolled in a Catholic school or in the Parish Religious Education program for at least 2 years in order to be confirmed in 8th Grade.

High School students and older must be enrolled in our Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults process (English or Spanish) in order to be confirmed.

MARRIAGE / MATRIMONY

Couples need to consult one of the priests of the parish at least 6 months before wedding date.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Sirach 27:4-7

This reading explains that quality and truth in conversation is a test for humankind. Only after listening to a person's reasoning can we know the mind of another.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:54-58

Paul speaks of the mystery of transformation that is victory over death when our mortality puts on immortality. We are encouraged by Paul to be steadfast and immovable, filling our lives with the work of the Lord.

Gospel: Luke 6:39-45

Today, Jesus teaches through the use of parables, first encouraging us to be like the teacher, understand that the blind cannot lead the blind. Jesus also reminds us that only the heart's good treasure produces good. In order to remain steadfast, we must heed what Jesus tells us. If we hear God's word, our foundation will be strong, unshaken, steadfast, built upon rock.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

"As the test of what the potter molds is in the furnace, so in tribulation is the test of the just. The fruit of the tree shows the care it has had, so too does one's speech disclose the bent of one's mind. Praise no one before he speaks for it then that people are tested...a good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good."

The scriptures use so many images to teach us, form us, and lead us. Consider for a moment... the potter shapes an object, maybe your coffee mug, a vase to hold a spring flower, or even ourselves. (Abba, Father). Soon trees will begin to bud, and the care we give them now, pruning, trimming, fertilizing, will produce long awaited fruit. The words we use, reflect how we feel, what we know and what we desire.

We need not limit ourselves to the image of a tree, but apply the teaching to our own way of life. How we walk the path of holiness according to the teaching of Pope Francis is found in the beatitudes. Our words, our thoughts, our good works are the steps we take on that path, accompanied by God's grace and the support of one another.

Evangelio: San Lucas 6:39-45

Jesús enseña por medio de parábolas, primero alentándonos a ser como un maestro, a entender que el ciego no puede guiar ciegos. Jesús nos recuerda que sólo la bondad del corazón produce el bien. Para permanecer rectos debemos oír lo que Jesús nos dice. Si escuchamos a Dios, nuestra base será fuerte, inamovible, recta, erigida sobre roca.

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

"El horno pone a prueba los vasos del alfarero, y la prueba del hombre está en sus conversaciones. El árbol bien cultivado se manifiesta en sus frutos; así la palabra expresa la índole de cada uno. No elogies a nadie antes de oírlo razonar, porque allí es donde se prueban los hombres... El hombre bueno saca el bien del tesoro de bondad que tiene en su corazón."

Las escrituras usan innumerables imágenes para enseñarnos, formarnos y guiarnos. Considere por un momento... el alfarero moldea un objeto, quizá una taza para café, un florero o quizá nos moldea a nosotros mismos. (Abba, padre). Pronto los árboles comienzan a retoñar, y los cuidados que les damos ahora, podándolos, recortándolos, abonándolos, producirán la muy esperada fruta. Las palabras que usamos reflejan cómo nos sentimos, lo que sabemos y lo que deseamos.

No necesitamos limitarnos a la imagen de un árbol, sino que podemos aplicar la enseñanza a nuestra propia forma de vida. Cómo caminamos el sendero de la santidad de acuerdo a las enseñanzas del Papa Francisco, se encuentra en las bienaventuranzas. Nuestras palabras, nuestros pensamientos, nuestras buenas obras son los pasos que nos llevan a ese sendero, acompañados por la gracia de Dios y el apoyo del uno al otro.
