Canon 867 §1.

Parents are *obliged* to take care that infants are *baptized in the first few weeks*; as soon as possible after the birth or even before it, they are to go to the pastor to request the sacrament for their child and to be prepared properly for it.

CONFIRMATION / CONFIRMACIÓN

Elementary school students must be baptized and enrolled in a Catholic school or in the Parish Religious Education program for at least 2 years in order to be confirmed in 8th Grade.

High School students and older must be enrolled in our Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults process (English or Spanish) in order to be confirmed.

MARRIAGE / MATRIMONY

Couples need to consult one of the priests of the parish at least 6 months before wedding date.

Available by appointment to the seriously infirmed and the aged.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Exodus 17:8-13

Amalek and his people attacked the Israelites, so Moses instructed Joshua to lead some of the Israelites into battle the next day. While Moses kept his hands raised in prayer, the Israelites were winning. But when he put his hands down, they would begin to lose. So, the others helped him keep his hands raised, and Joshua and the Israelites won the battle.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 3:14 – 4:2

Paul tell Timothy that the Scriptures are inspired by God and are an excellent tool in teaching others about God's expectations of his people. Knowledge of the Scriptures, coupled with faith in Jesus, will lead many people to salvation. Paul urges Timothy to continue preaching the gospel, although this will sometimes be a difficult task."

Gospel: Luke 18:1-8

Jesus speaks about a corrupt judge who lacked respect for either God or man. A widow repeatedly asked him to settle a case in her favor. He finally settled the case, only because he grew weary of listening to her requests. Jesus points out that if even this corrupt judge eventually listened, then God, who is just and will certainly answer the pleas of his people."

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

"Remain faithful to what you have learned and believed, because you know from whom you have learned it, and from infancy you have known the sacred scriptures, which are capable of giving you wisdom for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All scriptures are inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction and for training in righteousness, so that those who belong to Jesus may be competent, equipped for every good work."

When is the last time you opened your bible at home, or listened with great attention as the scriptures were proclaimed at mass? When did you reflect on God's word, during the week after hearing it at liturgy, or heard a text which was familiar to you? When did you think it might be helpful to attend a bible study?

The words above which Paul wrote to Timothy are invitations to us, so we can grow in our faith. The teachings remind us of growing after first communion, confirmation or our marriage. We continue to grow older, are we growing in holiness? Pope Francis' exhortation offers us the beatitudes as the path for holiness. The bible in your living room has allergies. It is allergic to dust. Please open it read it and heed it!

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura: Éxodo 17:8-13

Los amalecitas atacaron a los israelitas. Moisés instruyó a Josué a dirigir a los israelitas en la batalla del día siguiente. Mientras Moisés oraba con las manos alto, los israelitas ganaban. Cuando bajaba las manos, empezaba a perder. Otros dos ayudaron a Moisés a mantener las manos en alto y Josué y los israelitas ganaron la batalla.

Segunda Lectura: 2 Timoteo 3:14 – 4:2

Pablo le dice a Timoteo que las escrituras han sido inspiradas por Dios y son una herramienta excelente al enseñar a otros acerca de lo que Dios espera de su pueblo. El conocimiento de las escrituras y la fe en Jesús llevarán a muchos a la salvación. Pablo incita a Timoteo a seguir predicando el evangelio, a pesar de lo difícil que pueda ser.

Evangelio: San Lucas 18:1-8

Jesús habla de un juez corrupto que no tenía respeto ni por Dios ni por ninguno. Una viuda numerosamente le pidió decidir un caso a su favor. Finalmente lo hizo porque se cansó de escucharla. Jesús indica que, si aun este juez corrupto escucho, Dios, quien es justo definitivamente escuchara los ruegos de su gente.

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

"Pero tu permanece fiel a la doctrina que aprendiste y de la que estas plenamente convencido: tu sabes de quienes las has recibido. Recuerda que desde la niñez conoces las Sagradas Escrituras: ellas pueden darte la sabiduría que conduce a la salvación, mediante la fe en Cristo Jesús. Toda la Escritura está inspirada por Dios, y es útil para enseñar y para argüir, para corregir y para educar en la justicia, al fin de que el hombre de Dios sea perfecto y esté preparando para hacer siempre el bien."

¿Cuándo fue la última vez que abrió usted una biblia en casa, o escucho con gran atención la lectura de las escrituras proclamadas en la misa? ¿Cuándo reflexiono en la palabra de Dios durante la semana luego de escucharla en la liturgia, o de haber escuchado un texto que le era familiar? ¿Cuándo piensa usted que sería útil asistir a un estudio bíblico?

Las palabras que escribió San Pablo a Timoteo son una invitación a nosotros, para que crezcamos en nuestra fe. La enseñanza nos recuerda como crecimos luego de la primera comunión, confirmación y matrimonio. Continuamos creciendo en años, creciendo en santidad. La exhortación del Papa Francisco nos ofrece las bienaventuranzas como el camino a la santidad. La biblia en la sala de su casa tiene alergias. Es alérgica al polvo. Por favor, ¡ábrala, léala y póngale atención!
