Canon 867 §1.

Parents are *obliged* to take care that infants are *baptized in the first few weeks*; as soon as possible after the birth or even before it, they are to go to the pastor to request the sacrament for their child and to be prepared properly for it.

Elementary school students must be baptized and enrolled in a Catholic school or in the Parish Religious Education program for at least 2 years in order to be confirmed in 8th Grade.

High School students and older must be enrolled in our Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults process (English or Spanish) in order to be confirmed.

MARRIAGE / MATRIMONY

Couples need to consult one of the priests of the parish at least 6 months before wedding date.

**TODAY'S READINGS****First Reading: Sirach 35:12-14, 16-18**

God is just and does not show favoritism, but hears the prayers of everyone. Anyone who serves God, no matter how lowly his position here on earth, will be heard and answered.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 4:6-8, 16-18

Paul writes to Timothy that he thinks his mission is near the end, and he is glad his faith is still strong. Paul hopes that all nations will hear the Gospel. But, if he is executed as he anticipates, he is sure he will live forever in heaven.

Gospel: Luke 18:9-14

Jesus tells a parable about a Pharisee who went to the temple, and offered up a prayer of thanks because he was not a sinner like the tax collector who was also there to pay. The tax collector was far more humble, acknowledging his sins, and asking forgiveness for them. Jesus said the tax collector's prayer would be heard because, "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, while he who humbles himself will be exalted."

LECTURAS DE HOY**Primera Lectura: Sirac 35:12-14, 16-18**

Dios es justo y no muestra favoritismo. Él escucha las oraciones de todos. Aquel que sirve a Dios, sin importar su baja posición en la tierra, será escuchado y se le responderá.

Segunda Lectura: 2 Timoteo 4:6-8, 16-18

Pablo le escribe a Timoteo que siente que su misión pronto acabará, y que se alegra de que su fe sea fuerte todavía. Pablo espera que todas las naciones escuchen el evangelio. Pero que si es ejecutado como piensa, está seguro de que vivirá en el cielo eternamente.

Evangelio: San Lucas 18:9-14

Jesús cuenta una parábola sobre un fariseo que fue al templo y ofreció una oración de gracias por no ser un pecador como el cobrador de impuestos que también está orando. El cobrador era más humilde, reconociendo sus pecados y pidiendo perdón. Jesús dijo que la oración del cobrador sería escuchada porque "el que a sí mismo se engrandece será humillado, y el que se humilla será engrandecido".

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

"The Lord is God of justice, who knows no favorites. Though not unduly partial to the weak, yet he hears the cry of the oppressed. The Lord is not deaf to the wail of the orphan, nor to the widow when she pours out her complaint. The one who serves God willingly is heard, his petition reaches the heavens... Oh God, be merciful to me a sinner."

The parable of Jesus provides a clear and poignant teaching. We can identify only with one of the two persons. The writer from the Jewish scriptures provides us with the oppressed or the one who serves God willingly. I too can identify as one of them.

If God hears the cry of the poor, can I as a willing servant hear and listen to their voice? Christians throughout the world are suffering great hardship, precisely because of their faith. Do I respond to their need? I may not know them, their language, or culture, but they are victims of oppression and neglect. From earliest times the bible responds to the widows and orphan.

Those detained at our border are sufferers and seekers of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. Can I see them as us? Pope Francis stated that God's last name is 'Mercy'. Does the word of God today call me to compassion and action?

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

"El señor es juez y no hace distinción de personas: no se muestra parcial contra el pobre y escucha la súplica del oprimido; no desoye la plegaria del huérfano, ni a la viuda cuando expone su queja. El que rinde el culto que agrada el Señor es aceptado, y su plegaria llega hasta las nubes... ¡Dios mío, ten piedad de mí que soy un pecador!"

La parábola de Jesús provee una enseñanza clara y conmovedora. Nos podemos identificar con solo una de las dos personas. El autor de las escrituras judías nos ofrece al oprimido y al que sirve a Dios voluntariamente. Yo también puedo identificarme como uno de ellos.

Si Dios escucha la súplica del pobre, ¿puedo yo, como siervo, voluntariamente, oír y escuchar esta voz? Los cristianos del mundo entero sufren gran adversidad, precisamente por su fe. ¿Respondo a su necesidad? Puede que no los conozca, ni su lenguaje o cultura, pero son víctimas de opresión y descuido. Desde tiempos antiguos, la biblia responde a las viudas y huérfanos.

Gente detenida en nuestras fronteras sufren y buscan la vida, la libertad, y la felicidad. ¿Puedo verlos como uno de nosotros? El Papa Francisco afirmó que el apellido de Dios es 'Misericordia'. ¿Me llama hoy la palabra de Dios a la compasión y la acción?

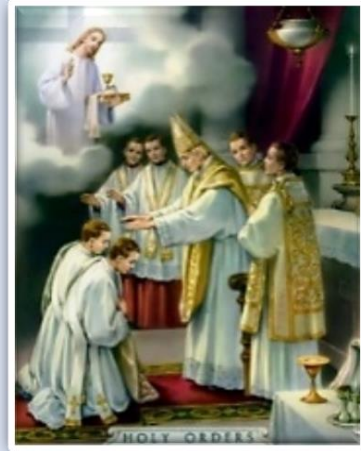
