
SPONSOR FORMS FOR BAPTISM & CONFIRMATION

Not your childhood parish where you received your sacraments. In order for the form to be signed the following requirements need to be met:

- I am a registered, active member of Parishioner of St. Patrick's Church.
- If married, my marriage is recognized as valid by the Catholic Church.
- ◆ I am at least 14 years of age and have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation in the Catholic Church.
- I attend Mass regularly on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation and receive the Sacraments of the Church regularly.
- ◆ I am prepared to assist the parents in their Christian duties by my support.
