A Note from the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

The season of Lent is upon us. On Ash Wednesday this week, the whole Church will begin a time of penance and preparation for the Tridium and the Easter Celebrations. If we take Lent seriously, it can be a time of renewal and strength of our life of faith. It is sad to say that many people are too busy or preoccupied with distractions to the spiritual life to take much advantage of the penitential focus of the 40 days. It is not that we are supposed to live in gloom or misery for the six weeks, but we are asked to recognize our need for reprentance, forgiveness and renewal. We are encouraged to make sacrifices either by giving up or taking on something or both. Our Lenten practices should help us focus our hearts on God.

We can make sacrifices by giving up some favorite things. The absence of certain comforts or treats helps us to think of much greater sacrifices that were made for us by Christ himself, or the difficult conditions many people are forced to live under. We can thank Jesus for His love for us and we can seek to follow His example. We can also resolve to pray for those who are persecuted or who are less fortunate than we are.

We should also resolve to turn away from sin each and every day with the help of God's grace. We should be trying to pray more and help those around us. Most certainly, we should stay close to the sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation. There are extra times of prayer during Lent such as the Friday Stations of the Cross and a noon weekday Mass. As mentioned once before, we will have a Mission from April 1 to 5. Fr. Bisignano arranged the Mission about 1 year ago, and it is my prayer that Fr. Collins (who is giving the retreat) will inspire us and lead us into greater holiness.

When Ash Wednesday comes, let us be ready to turn to God with all our heart.

"The season of Lent is a preparation for the celebration of Easter. The liturgy prepares the catechumens (those adults preparing for Baptism) for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery by the several stages of Christian Initiation; it also prepares the faithful, who recall their own baptism and do penance in preparation for Easter." - General Norms for the Liturgical Year, 27

By the threefold discipline of **fasting**, **prayer**, and **almsgiving** the Church keeps Lent from Ash Wednesday until the evening of Holy Thursday. All of the faithful and the catechumens should undertake serious practice of these three traditions.

FASTING

"When you fast, see to it that you groom your hair and wash your face. In that way no one can see that you are fasting except your Father who is hidden; and your Father who sees what is hidden will repay you." -Matthew 6:17

THE LENTEN REGULATIONS FOR THIS YEAR ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Abstinence from meat</u> is observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on **Ash Wednesday**, on all of the **Fridays of Lent**, and on **Good Friday**.
- 2. <u>Fasting</u> must be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between their 18th and 60th birthdays. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. (Fasting is strongly encouraged Mondays through Saturdays of Lent, not required).

There is a serious obligation to observe these penitential practices in a substantial way. Those whose work or health would be impaired are excused from fast and abstinence. Individual conscience should decide proper cause for excuse. A more serious reason is required to excuse oneself from Ash Wednesday fast and abstinence – or from the fast and abstinence of Good Friday.

The tradition of "giving up" something for Lent is a way to "fast" from those habits that keep us from focusing our lives on God. We can also consider "taking on" an extra practice during Lent: daily Mass, praying Morning or Evening Prayer, serving in a soup kitchen, visiting the sick, or even practicing greater patience with our loved ones.

PRAYER

"In the days when Christ was in the flesh, he offered prayers and supplications...and he was heard because of his reverence. Son though he was, he learned obedience from what he suffered; and when perfected, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him." - Hebrews 5:7-9

ALMSGIVING

"When you give alms, do not blow a trumpet before you as the hypocrites do... to win the praise of others." (Matthew 6:2).

"Do not neglect to do good and share what you have; God is pleased with sacrifices of that kind." (Hebrews 13:16).

Next week, on the First Sunday of Lent, another insert will have suggestions for practicing these disciplines of **PRAYER** and **ALMSGIVING**.
