Passion Sunday & Passiontide

The Fifth Sunday of Lent (Passion Sunday in years past) marks a change of focus in Lent as we make a more proximate preparation for the commemoration of the Lord's passion and death (Passiontide). In some places crosses and statues are covered or removed altogether. This old custom is a way of focusing on the penitential aspect of this liturgical season. The veiling was associated with Passion Sunday's Gospel (John 8:46-59), in which Jesus "hid himself" from the people. In addition, it reminds us in a visual way that our faith in all its glory is made possible only through the work of Christ in His suffering and death on the cross. When we cover or remove these holy and sacred images that we are so accustomed to, we are starkly confronted and reminded in a poignant way of all that Christ has won for us. Here at Seton, the crosses in the sanctuary are veiled and pussy willows appear in the sanctuary. Since Poland and Eastern Europe are lacking the palms indigenous to Jerusalem, those peoples developed their own tradition. On Palm Sunday, the "palms" or branches that people carry to the church are made of blooming pussy willows branches called *bazie* or *kotki* decorated with branches of birch, raspberry, currant and also some boxwood *bukspan*, dry flowers and grass, ribbons and other decorations. For Christians, the willow (Polish: *wierzba*) symbolizes the resurrection and the immortality of the soul. As such, pussy willows are a good symbol for Lent as they hold the promise of resurrection within their stark branches.

The Wisdom of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen:

Only God bring happiness. Lenten practices of giving up pleasures are good reminders that the purpose of life is not pleasure. The purpose of life is to attain to perfect life, all truth and undying ecstatic love – which is the definition of God. In pursuing that goal we find happiness. **Pleasure is not the purpose of anything; pleasure is a by-product resulting from doing something that is good.** One of the best ways to get happiness and pleasure out of life is to ask ourselves, "How can I please God?" and, "Why am I not better?" It is the pleasure-seeker who is bored, for all pleasures diminish with repetition.

Monthly Prayer Intentions of Pope Francis

The Holy Father asks the people of the world to pray with him for the following during March:

Evangelization: Formation in Spiritual Discernment. That the Church may appreciate the urgency of formation in spiritual discernment, both on the personal and communitarian levels.

A Note about Becoming Sponsors For Baptism and Confirmation

It is a great honor to be asked to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation. The role of a "godparent" is to be an "other parent" in matters of our holy Faith. That is why sponsors must be **practicing Catholics, 16 years of age or older (14 years old in the Archdiocese of New York), having received Catholic Confirmation and currently living a good Christian moral life. If the sponsor is married, that person must be in a valid Catholic Church marriage.** One sponsor is required for Confirmation. It is customary to have two for Baptism, in which case one must be male and the other female. Parents may not be sponsors. A baptized non-Catholic may replace the second Baptism sponsor as a Christian witness. Non-Christians may not be Sponsors. Former Catholics may not be sponsors.

A nominated sponsor is asked to get certification from his/her current parish. This is a declaration by a priest/deacon that the individual is qualified to be a sponsor according to Church Law. To be so certified, the individual must be a **current parishioner of the particular parish where the certification is being sought, and be known to the priest/deacon as being a faithful practicing Catholic, attending Mass there weekly.**

Those away at college or graduate school or in the military should seek certification from their campus ministries or chaplains.

Unfortunately, at times, family members or friends are chosen to be sponsors with good intentions, but are found to be ineligible according to Church Law. Also, more and more, people seem to think that they are still "parishioners" of their childhood parish, where they attended school or received sacraments years ago, while no longer living in the area or attending Mass there regularly. **It is important for all individuals to be active members of their local Catholic faith communities.**

Here, at Seton, Certificates of Sponsorship are given by the pastor to registered members of the parish who are practicing Catholics, and who meet the above criteria. Please see the pastor after Mass on Saturday evening or Sunday to inquire about getting a certificate.

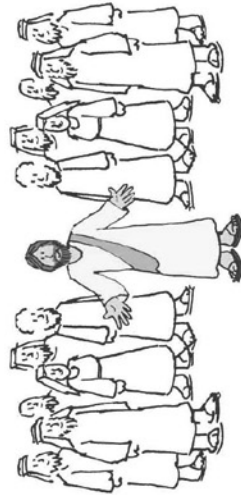
