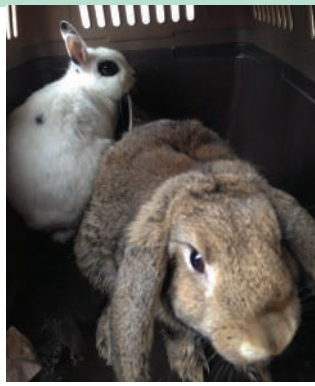
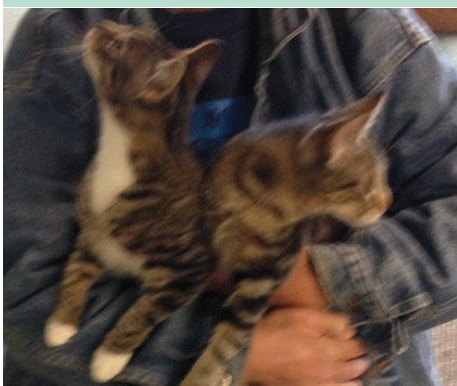

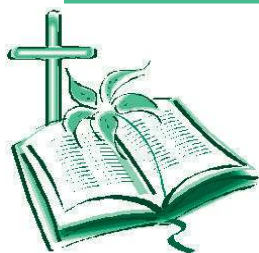

### Surviving the Holidays – Thoughts on Coping with Grief

There is no right or wrong way to handle the day. Some may wish to follow family traditions, while others may choose to change.

Focus your celebrations on winter: go to a mountain lodge, go sledding or skiing, or just take a walk in the woods-timeout to enjoy what nature has to offer in this season.

Include the deceased in your conversations and celebrations. Hang a stocking for your loved one in which people can put notes with their thoughts or feelings. Look at photographs. Once others realize that you are comfortable talking about your loved one, they can relate stories that will add to your pleasant memories.

Keep in mind the feelings of your children or family members. Try to make the holiday season as joyous as possible for them.

Plan to be with the people you enjoy. Do something for others: volunteer at a soup kitchen, visit the lonely and shut-ins, ask someone who is alone to share the day with your family, provide help for a needy family, volunteer at the airport to pour coffee for stranded travelers, or offer to volunteer in a hospital on the holiday. If your city has a Ronald McDonald House, see if you can help make their holiday happier.

Don't be afraid to express your feelings. Allow people to comfort you. They need to feel they are helping in some way.

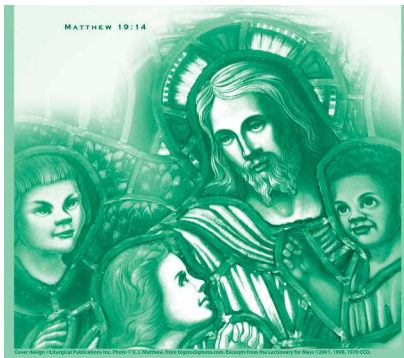

## Kinder-garden Corner

It is hard to believe that we are already at the end of our first quarter of school!!! We have spent this time beginning our Kindergarten journey. We have been learning about our classroom structure, routine and rules. We've learned about the letters of the alphabet AND we are learning to read already!!! We've talked about patterns and sorting and numbers in Math Readiness and we have been tree scientists in Science!! We have been busy little beavers!!

While I enjoy watching my little ones learn their ABC's and 123's, and the excitement they show when they have accomplished a goal, my favorite time is when we are sharing our faith. We have Religion class daily in our room, and we go to Mass each Wednesday with the rest of the school. There is nothing like sitting with a group of five year olds during Mass! In the beginning of the year, Mass can be something of an aerobic outing as my little ones get used to sitting, standing, and kneeling like the big kids do. We have the occasional foot caught under the kneeler, or the slip off the kneeler and under the pew, or, my personal favorite, the finger stuck in a hole in the box where the missals go. Then there are the sideways looks with the inquiry of how much longer and will we have snack when we get back. But as the quarter progresses, and they learn the ritual of the Mass, they become observant ("Look, Fr. Joe is wearing green."), and aware ("Is this when we take the walk?" as we prepare to go up to be blessed at Communion.) They process up to be blessed, angelically crossing their arms and then solemnly returning to their pew and kneeling to pray. Looking at them as they pray, respond, and sing, brings a warmth to my heart and a smile to my face, as I'm sure it does Our Lord as He looks down upon them, too.



I encourage you to join us at one of our school Masses on a Wednesday. There is something special about celebrating the liturgy with children and listening to their participation and singing. Thank you to our parishioners from Holy Family and St. Augustine for your continued support to our mission of Catholic education. May God bless you! See you some Wednesday!!

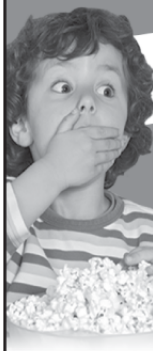
