Please contact the parish office to schedule a baptism. It is recommended that parents seeking Baptism for their child attend two baptismal preparation classes.


#### Sacrament of Marriage:

# Be Filled with Fr. Phil

#### **First Holy Communion**

This Sunday, we will be celebrating First Holy Communion at St. Augustine at two offerings of Holy Mass. Congratulations to all our First Holy Communicants! Please offer your prayers for them and their loved ones on this very special day. It is a tremendous gift to receive Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Holy Eucharist! How glorious that these young ones will now be able to receive Him every Sunday (and hopefully more often!).

#### Catholic Services Appeal (CSA)

This month from our local shepherd, Archbishop Vigneron, we are reminded of our Christian duty to care for our brothers and sisters throughout the entire Church of Detroit (Archdiocese) through the efforts and good work performed through the CSA. Because of the scope of this work, all parishes throughout the Archdiocese participate in this endeavor for the good of the whole Church. Since individually we cannot take care of all the needs of the faithful, the CSA provides an avenue through which good outreach work can be performed.

Each of our parishes in our Family has already been assigned their targeted goal. As you may know, the CSA is something that each parish must fulfill. If the goal is not met, then donations given through offertory will be depleted to have to make that goal. I am very familiar with individuals who will say that the best way to get "the message" across to the bishops is not to give to the church. Please do not resort to such passive aggressive tactics. Instead, try and communicate with the bishops by letter or phone call. I know the rebuttal to that would be: either no communication is returned or something that is given will be less satisfactory. Yet, I think

communication offered is a better way to reaching the bishops rather than hurting one's own parish community.

All the overage that is collected through CSA will benefit our parishes by 100%. How? All overage collected through the CSA will not be subject to diocesan assessment or "taxed" and the funds collected will not negatively impact the CSA goal for the next three years. All donations made to our offertory will be "taxed" (a small percentage will go toward the diocese) and the amount will be included in the calculation of our CSA goal for the next three years. Donations designated for Christmas will not be "taxed" but will still contribute to the calculation of our CSA goal for the next three years. This is why giving donations through CSA will benefit our parishes by 100%.

For St. Mary Mystical Rose, we are looking for your help and support to help the beautiful ministry that we have at the Armada Fair. Long story short, we are in need of a fire suppression system as well as a commercial grade hood that will work in tandem with it. After acquiring quotes, the amount of this comes to \$25,000. Without it, our food booth would not be permitted to operate which would be quite the blow to us as well as to our community. I will be talking about it the next time I have both Masses at St. Mary Mystical Rose

For St. Augustine, during the Masses this weekend, I will be introducing our "Adopt a Classroom" initiative. In short, the hope is to enhance the learning atmosphere for our students and attract new families to consider sending their children to our school. The entirety of what we are trying to accomplish would include these key enhancements: new

flooring, a drop ceiling, ceiling fans, and new lighting. Due to a very generous individual, everything that has to do with the new flooring in the school classrooms this year has been donated. We are very blessed that he has helped us immensely in this project. This work will begin around the middle of June. For all the sixteen classrooms, the amount that needs to be raised comes to the tune of \$45,000. This is called "Adopt a Classroom" because the hope is that if an individual is willing to donate at least \$2800, we can provide some recognition in a classroom that reflects the donor's generosity, dedicating the classroom to him or her. If a few individuals or families raised that amount together and informed us, we can be sure to have a particular classroom dedicated to them as a group.

For Holy Family, while the Finance Council has not identified any special initiatives at this time, we are very much in need of donations to help our operating expenses.

Please consider giving generously to our parishes through CSA, especially in support of special projects.



# **Corpus Christi Procession**

- Walk With Jesus -

**Sunday, June 19, 2022** 

Very early (in the fourteenth century) the custom developed of carrying the Blessed Sacrament in a splendid procession through the town after the Mass on Corpus Christi Day. This was encouraged by the popes, some of whom granted special indulgences to all participants. The Council of Trent (1545-1563)solemnly approved and recommended the procession on Corpus Christi as a public profession of the Catholic faith in the real presence of Christ in the Holy Sacrament.

During the later Middle Ages these processions developed into splendid pageants of devotion and honor to the Blessed Sacrament. They are still publicly held, and often with the ancient splendor, in Italy, France, Spain, Portugal, Austria, Belgium, Ireland, in the Catholic sections of Holland. Switzerland. Germany, Canada, Hungary, in the Slavic countries and South America. Sovereigns and princes, presidents and ministers of the state, magistrates, members of trade and craft guilds, and honor guards of the armed forces accompany the liturgical procession while the church bells peal, bands play sacred hymns, and the faithful kneel in front of their homes to adore the Eucharistic Lord. —

If you are unable to walk in the procession but want to be a part of the procession, the hay wagon offers an opportunity to do so. Also, there are two stops along the way where there will a time for a small rest, a quick snack and water where porta potties are available.

A shuttle bus will begin running from Holy Family to St. Augustine around 6:00 a.m. and will run until around 7:30 a.m.

What a beautiful way to honor God on Father's Day, coming together, openly showing our belief in the true body, by Walking With Jesus, praying and singing Him praises.

As Catholics, we can use this time to grow and bring life into our relationship with Mary, the Mother of

What we know about Mary, we get from the Bible, which is very little. This is surprising because she has an important role in our faith. Without her, we wouldn't have Jesus as our Savior. From the moment she was conceived, she was devoted to God. She was born without original sin and she is sinless. Mary always had complete trust and faith in God, she never wavered. She loves all of us and is willing to go to her son, Jesus, on our behalf. She constantly prays for us and constantly gives glory to God. Mary is worthy of honor.

What can we do to get to know Mary better? I asked the 4th grade students that question. They answered by saying "pray to her", "read the Bible", and "pray the rosary". These answers are good and true. I will add to that. Below are some ways to get to know Mary better.

- Since May is the month of Mary, you can create a Mary altar. Use any table and cover it with a tablecloth. Then place a Mary statue on the table. Other items can be included like art work, a candle, artificial or real flowers, or pictures with Mary in them. Praying the Hail Mary or other prayers can be prayed there either alone or with others.
- Have a May Crowning. This is when a crown, usually made out of flowers, will be placed on Mary's head. Prayers can be prayed and songs can be sung.
- Pray the Rosary while meditating on the mysteries. My favorite mysteries to know Mary better are the Joyful Mysteries the and Glorious Mysteries.
- Listen to Marian hymns. The sounds are beautiful and so are the words.
- Talk to her in prayer. Prayer is a dialogue. Ask her to intercede for you. She is happy to do that for us.

May is a good time to grow and live our relationship with Mary, just like spring is a good time to celebrate her. However, we can grow and live our relationship with her anytime. It can be any month, day, or hour. The closer we become to Mary, the closer we become to her son Jesus.



#### PROPER ENVELOPE USAGE

Did you know that there is a right way and a wrong way to use your Sunday envelopes? Please note the following items when using your collection envelopes.

- 1. USE YOUR ENVELOPE In most cases, it is the only way for us to know when you are here. (If you are ever asked to be a godparent or confirmation sponsor, you will need to provide proof that you attend Mass regularly.) If you are unable to contribute anything, turn in your envelope anyway. If you give electronically and still turn in your envelope, please write 0 (zero) for the amount of your contribution. Do not write in the amount of your electronic contribution.
- 2. WRITE YOUR
  CONTRIBUTION AMOUNT ON
  THE SPACE PROVIDED ON
  THE OUTSIDE OF THE

**ENVELOPE** - This allows the counters to simply verify your figure as opposed to writing how much is in the envelope. This helps us to give you proper credit for your donation.

# 3. PLEASE DO NOT TAPE OR STAPLE YOUR ENVELOPE

SHUT - This greatly increases the amount of time the counters need to spend opening the envelopes and it can cause damage to the envelope which could interfere with giving you proper credit for your donation.
