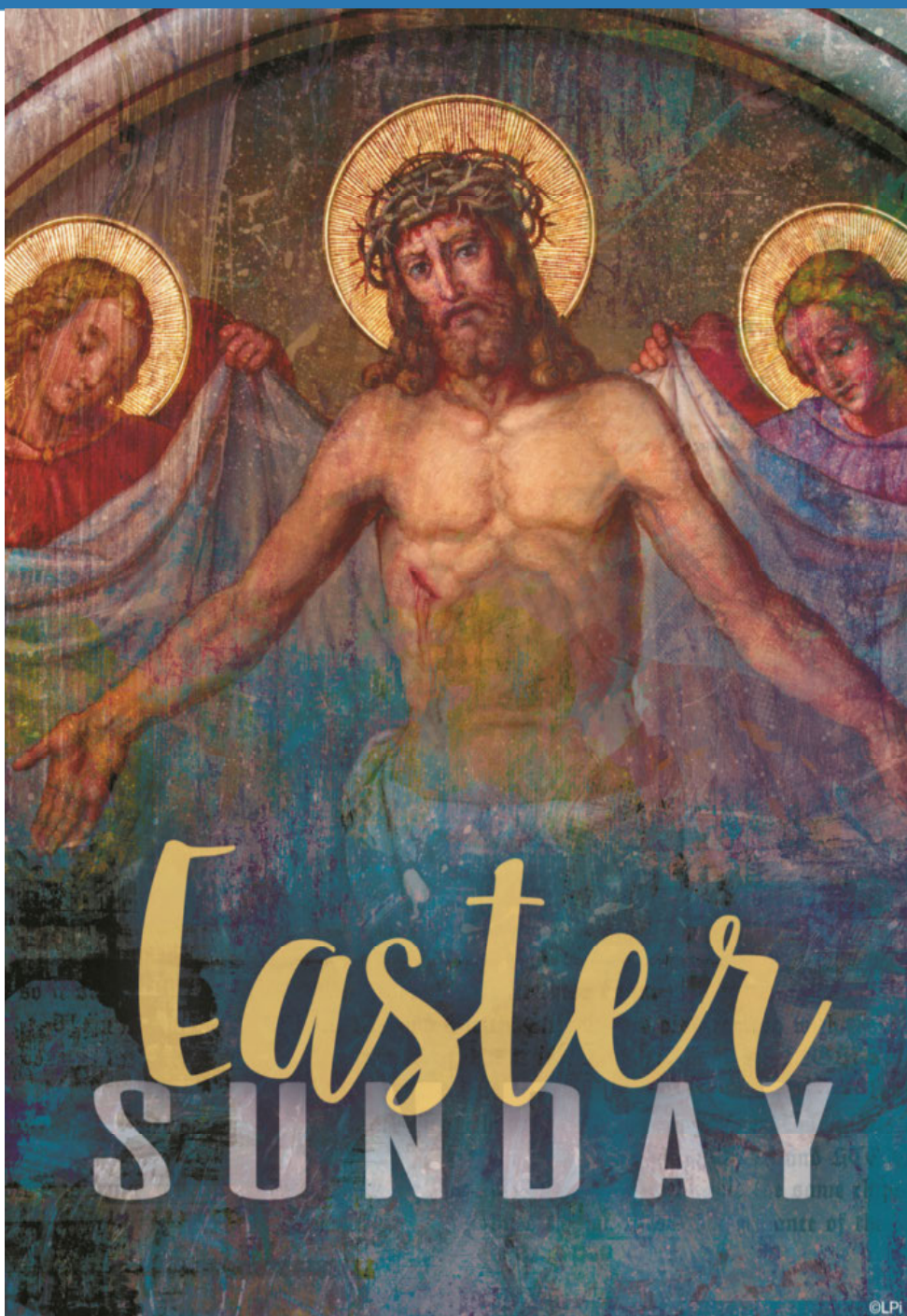

### From Msgr. Pat

The first time I was privileged to visit the Holy Land, I went with my sister, Kathy, brother-in-law, Ken, and my 9-month-old nephew, Leo in December, 1984. Kathy and Ken were living in London. They weren't sure how long they'd be overseas and decided to go to Israel for Christmas. They invited me along. I was on the seminary faculty, and so had the Christmas break. Of course, I said "yes"!

I never dreamed I'd make this pilgrimage. I'd had a course on St. Matthew's Gospel from Fr. Jerome Murphy-O'Connor, an Irish Dominican who was teaching in Jerusalem at the Ecole Biblique, the oldest Catholic center for archeological and biblical studies in the Holy Land. Fr. Jerry and I became friends during the course of that summer. I loaned him my electric typewriter.

I wrote to him and told him we were coming to Jerusalem. I bought a copy of his *The Holy Land: An Oxford Archeological Guide*. When we arrived in Jerusalem, I called Fr. Jerry, and he invited us to lunch. During the meal he made all kinds of suggestions and invited us to join him with a group of UN friends for a trip to Bethlehem.

Ken asked about the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre. I foolishly (Ah, pride!) spoke up and said authoritatively, "Well, we can't be sure that that's actually Jesus' tomb..." Fr. Jerry cut me off. "On the contrary, of all the sites associated with Jesus' life and ministry, we have the greatest confidence about the tomb!"

He went on to explain that there is an unbroken tradition going back to the earliest days of the Christian community in Jerusalem that this is indeed the tomb of Jesus. Even when the Roman emperor, Marcus Aurelius (161-180) erected a temple to Jupiter over the tomb, and forbade Christians to visit under pain of death, disciples risked all and still came. Kathy, Ken, Leo and I went to the Basilica!

Constantine had his mother, St. Helena, an early pilgrim to the Holy Land, erect a church over the site of the tomb (while preserving the tomb itself). While that church was later destroyed, the tomb in the present church remains.

The February pilgrims and I visited the tomb which sits in a small chapel within the great basilica of the Holy Sepulchre. Such a visit is deeply moving as you can well imagine. When I was there with my sister and her parish group last November, we had the privilege of celebrating Mass over the tomb. Tears well up as I remember that moment.

All of which is to say: a most blessed Easter to you and all whom you love. Jesus has truly risen. His tomb is empty. I testify to this. Come to His altar table and meet Him. Let Him give you His Body and Blood. Taste eternal life!

A special welcome to those who are visiting, or home from school, or who have been away for whatever reason. Come, meet Jesus, and fall in love with Him Who already loves us more than we can imagine.

May God bless you throughout this Easter Season.

## Thank God for ANSWERED PRAYERS

God hears all prayers; He answers them all too (although the answer is not always yes). Sometimes the answer unfolds over time, and sometimes, like last week, it happens immediately.

Due to the shortage of priests, there were no clergy available to cover the 7:00pm Tuesday mass at Holy Family. So, a group of about 10 parishioners and I gathered to pray for priests. As I was at the ambo, I noticed a young man in the audience. He was 13 and sat with his mother and infant brother. After talking about the ministry of the priesthood and the shortage of priests, I called on him and asked if he'd ever considered the priesthood. "Not really" he said. "Has anyone else ever asked you about becoming a priest?" I asked. "I don't think so" he replied.

We then prayed several prayers for our intentions. We prayed the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, the AOD prayer for priests, the "Holy Hands" prayer and others. As we prayed I watched the young lad. He did not look bored, or distracted - on the contrary, his eyes were closed and he was fixated on the prayers. "This kid has it together" I thought. We closed with each person mentioning the name of a priest, followed by all of us offering a Hail Mary. (I'll bet we said nearly 50 Hail Mary's!).

As I went down the aisle to the exit, the young man caught my attention and approached me. He said, "Can I ask you a question?" "Sure" I said. "How do you know if I'm being called to the priesthood?"

So, there we were praying for priests, and directly after prayer, the only person in the church who was eligible for the priesthood (all others were old married guys, like me) expressed interest.

## Corpus Christi -Walk with Jesus Chairperson NEEDED

Our Corpus Christi procession, Walk with Jesus, began in 2008 when Holy Family was newly formed from Holy Rosary, St. Philip Neri, and All Saints. At that time, the walk started at Holy Rosary in Smiths Creek and ended at All Saints in Memphis. In 2010, after the closing of Holy Rosary, the Corpus Christi Walk With Jesus procession continued with a new route from Holy Family *Columbus* (St. Philp Neri) to Holy Family *Memphis* (All Saints). This continued until 2014 when the route once again changed, and the procession went from St. Augustine to Holy Family.

Fr. Joe Horn, Fr. Joe Mallia, Fr. Phil Ching, Fr. Sean Bonner, Fr. John Nedumcheril as well as Deacon Alan and Deacon Rich, have celebrated this Corpus Christi tradition. People from various cities come to join in the procession known as Walk With Jesus. Each year has its blessings and testimonies.

This year, to continue the tradition, a new chairperson is needed. We are sad to share that Judie Parks, who has been the Chairperson for the Corpus Christi walk for many years, is moving to a new community and will be stepping down. Judie is happy to work with anyone who would like to keep this tradition going. Please prayerfully consider this to give back to your Family of Parishes.
