From Msgr. Pat

One of my earliest memories is kneeling next to my mother in the old church at St. Michael, Pontiac, after she, my dad and brother came back from receiving Holy Communion. I was perhaps four or five. I didn't accompany them, and had no idea why they left the pew.

As so many did, she knelt and put her hands over her face, and made her thanksgiving. I tugged on her sleeve and said, "Don't cry, Mommy. Don't cry. It'll be okay." I don't recall what she said in response to my interrupting her prayer. I could see she wasn't crying, and that reassured me, so I could sit quietly, enveloped in another mystery, well beyond my understanding.

My mother, Phyllis, is an only child (I speak of her in the present tenses, even though she died in 1982. Of course, she's still alive, or else what am I doing with my life?!). Her mother, Bridget Loretta, is an Irish Catholic from the south side of Chicago. She and her sister used to wheel the first Mayor Daley around in his buggy. Her father, Jerome, was a Lutheran from mid-Michigan who worked for Buick in Flint. As a Protestant marrying a Catholic, he had to sign a promise that children would be raised Catholic. When Mom was born, he changed his mind. But he'd not reckoned with Bridget Loretta, who took Mom to St. Vincent DePaul in Pontiac and had her baptized anyway. And they

sent her to Catholic schools.

My grandmother prayed daily that my grandfather would come to the Eucharist. In the hospital, before he died, he did, near March 19, the Feast of St. Joseph, his Confirmation patron, and mine as well.

So, Phyllis has been gone from this world for 40 years, gone, but surely not forgotten. I tell people I have "Phyllis tapes," playing in my head regularly. "Stand up straight." "Eat the broccoli." "Write the thank you note now." These are only a small sample. I'm grateful for the tapes.

I'm most grateful that one of my earliest memories is kneeling next to my Mom at St. Michael, not sure what's going on, but knowing by her posture that it's important. I know that faith is God's gift to me. I know He gave it to me through Phyllis and Leo. When I give Him thanks this weekend at His altar, I'll thank Him for faith. And I'll thank Him for her, for them. I might have found the gift some other way, but it was so much easier because they received it first, and shared the gift so generously.

Happy Mother's Day, Phyllis, and Bridget Loretta, and all the holy women to whom we owe so much, and God bless them, everyone.

Why Are So Many People Kneeling on the Floor at St. Augustine School?

I always admire people who are always on the lookout for people that need some help. Helping others without being asked involves an awareness as well as a willingness to take action without hesitation. People who go above and beyond in this way lift others around them by being a living example of what Jesus teaches.

The middle school students have both of these qualities - awareness and helpfulness - and it is always uplifting to see them in action. I see it in the hallway all of the time and it gives me warm fuzzies. Inevitably, a student, in their attempt to transport all of their books and belongings from classroom to classroom, drops something in the hallway. Usually it is the item that is precariously balanced on the top of the pile of books in their arms that succumbs to the forces of gravity - *the full pencil case*. As soon as I hear that fateful noise, I know exactly how the next few minutes are going to play out . . . EVERY time. Students, sometimes two or three - usually more - stop what they are doing and drop to their knees. They immediately come to help gather all of the scattered items without a thought of what their priorities were seconds before.

The same thing happens when there is a water bottle spill. The puddle gets mopped up by any number of students on their hands and knees wielding their paper towels. It goes without saying that if someone needs assistance, the kids are there for each other.

It even happened to me last week in the faculty room. I turned to put my Pyrex dish with tuna casserole into the microwave. The bowl slipped out of my hands and I caught it half way down to the floor. Unfortunately, most of the potato chip topping flew out of the bowl and across the room. Mrs. Peck dropped to her knees and began cleaning up the crumbs before I even realized what had happened.

It is such a blessing to be surrounded by people who look out for each other and follow Jesus's teachings to take care of each other. I am blessed to be in the presence of people who are always willing to bend a knee to help those around them.

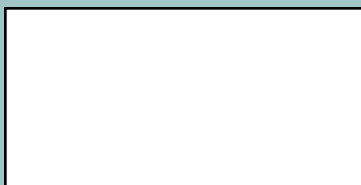

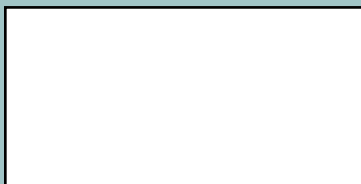
