Notify the parish office of any need for hospital or home visits.

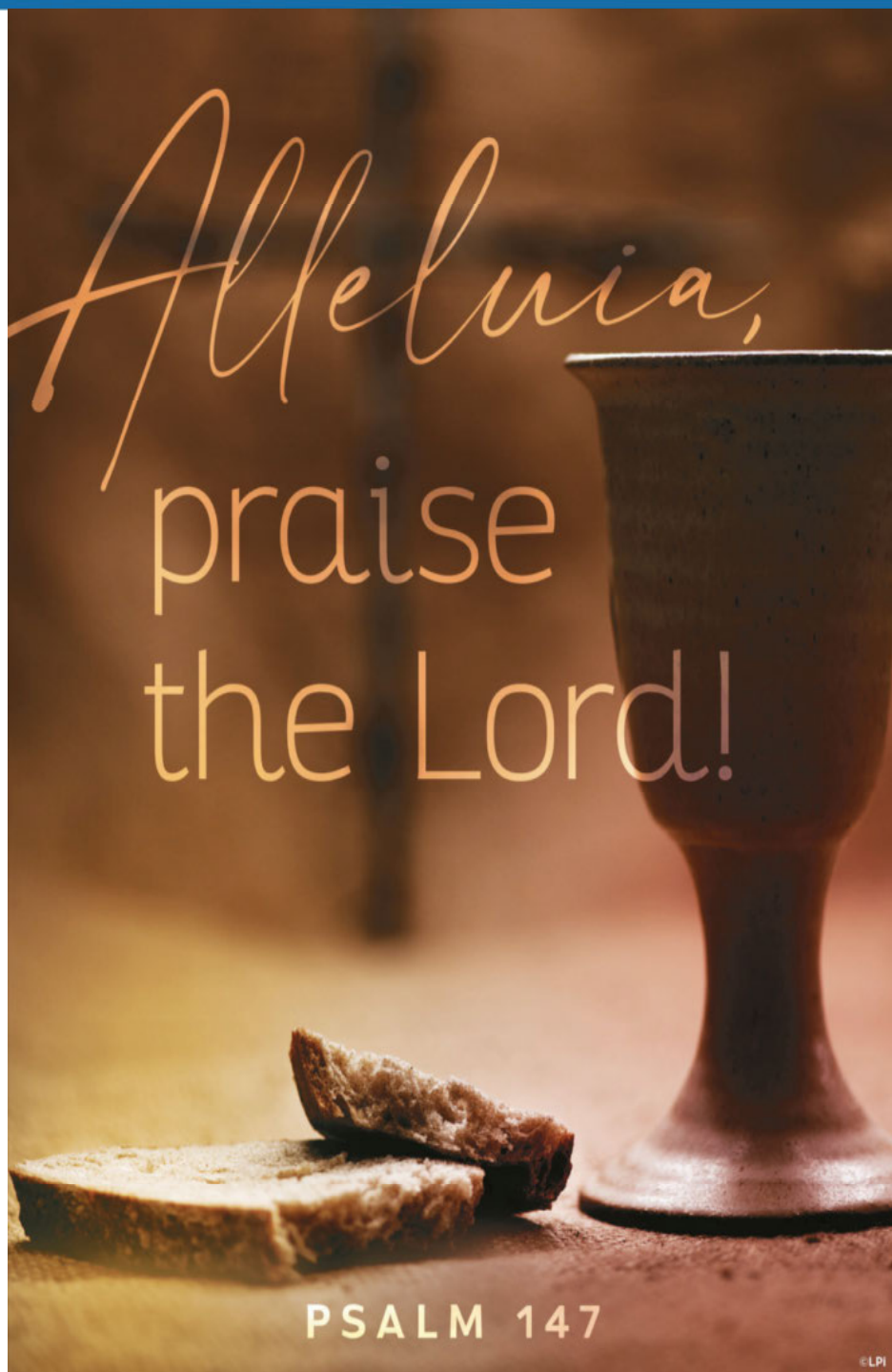

From Msgr. Pat

Some years back our fifth grade teacher sent me a collection of reflections which resulted from her assignment to the students to use their senses, and write about the experiences. Betty asked the students to spend 10 minutes in church, alert to all their senses. One student wrote the following:

"In my ten minutes of quiet observation I saw beautiful stain glass windows. I saw candles burning fiercely. I also saw the priest consecrating the Eucharist.

I heard when we sang our hymns. I heard the sound of the organ playing soft, mellow music. I heard the whispers of the people behind me.

I tasted the Eucharist. ***It tasted like I would never be hungry again*** (emphasis added). It tasted like it is really Jesus Christ. I also tasted the bitter blood of Jesus.

I smelled the holy water at the entrance. I smelled the Eucharist as I put it in my mouth. I also smelled the

blood as I drank it.

When I tasted the Eucharist I felt like I would never be hungry again. I felt the grace of the blood of Jesus. I also felt as if God would be in my life forever."

This young boy (he's a doctor now) gets to what novelist Graham Greene calls "the heart of the matter," it seems to me.

Last Sunday we heard John 3:16, "God so loved the world that he sent his only-begotten Son." Today we remember, we celebrate that he not only came, he stays with us.

We're here because we know that Jesus Christ satisfies our deepest hunger. We needn't look anywhere else. In the Eucharist God is present in my life, our lives forever. This is the good news our world, His world, desperately needs, hungers for. Ask the Holy Spirit how he wants you to share it.
