## From Fr. Mark Livingston

A happy and blessed Sunday to you! We are quickly coming to the end of the liturgical year (A), which ends the week of the Solemnity of Christ the King, 11/25 and 11/26. Gratitude and stewardship come to mind as we finish our first four months together. There are so many dedicated and caring individuals in our family of parishes who have done so much for which I am extremely grateful. Thank you for your dedication and commitment to serving in so many different ways in our churches. Fr. Kishore, Deacon Alan and Deacon Rich and I are filled with gratitude to you and to God for the gifts being used in our Family of Parishes to build up the Lord's Kingdom.

I remember when I was distancing myself from the Faith as a teenager and young adult—a fate we do not all have to share!—I thought that the Church cared excessively about money. I had this misunderstanding that “every homily” was about money or that the priests were “always talking about money.” I was wrong. In fact, compared with other Christian denominations that require a tithe (10% of gross income) from their congregation, the Catholic Church speaks about money very infrequently, relatively speaking. So, as we approach year end, I would like to make an appeal to each you before we begin the beautiful season of

Advent to consider your giving. First, this is a very generous community with your time, talent and treasure and I am so grateful to you. Almsgiving is a very important part of life in the Church and Jesus asks it of us. There are many ways to give and many people do very well in this regard.

You may have noticed in the bulletin that our weekly giving is off target to our budget, generally; some sites are doing better than others financially. In November, I will be releasing a giving strategy video for our parishes to be shown at Masses. This is not meant to be a constant nagging about money. In fact, I do not enjoy asking for money but I know it's necessary to continue providing services to people in need, keeping the heat and lights on in our buildings, and serving many other needs in our community. As is often the case, a fraction of the number of registered parishioners use their envelopes or give online on regular basis. Thank you to those who give to support our mission! I know some of you cannot give right now and I understand. Others might be able to but are not quite comfortable. Please be assured that I do not want to spend excessively and only want to be a good steward of your hard-earned resources.

I write you to prayerfully consider your giving. If you can give more,

please consider it. If you can start giving and have not yet begun, every little bit helps. Thank you! Also, the more we give above our Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) goal, the more that money comes back to us at 100% and is not subject to the Archdiocesan assessment for other services. So, once a month, I would like you to consider contributing to CSA rather than the parish because it will come back to the parish! More will be covered on this upcoming in the video. I thank you so much for your generous gifts in the past and for your continued giving in the future. I care about your soul primarily and want you and all of us to get to heaven. The structure that we operate to assist in that care costs a lot of money and many hands make light work. Thank you for your giving. I give too. Please consider how you can give. Maybe it's time, talent or treasure and consider making that offering to the Lord and his people.

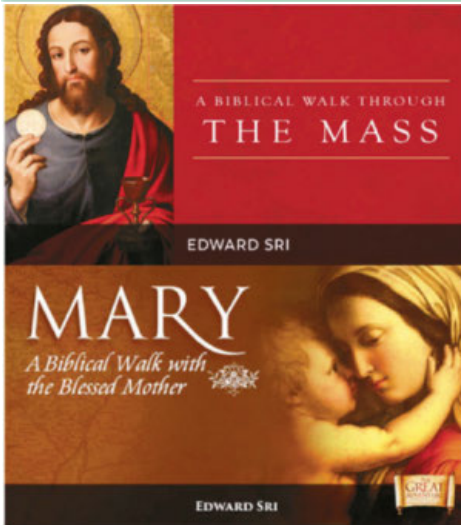
