Faith and Mercy Nights

Please join Fr. Mark and other members of the Merciful Love of Jesus Family of Parishes twice monthly for Faith and Mercy Nights. These events will take place on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of the month for six months, from January to June 2024, beginning at 7 PM.



On the 1st Wednesday of the month, Fr. Mark will lead a **teaching on a topic**. There will be a presentation followed by table discussion. Then we will have an open format period for question and answer. Any question is fair game! These evenings together are meant to be fun, uplifting and educational. From Fr. Mark Livingston

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! This is such a beautiful time of year, and it can be a painful time for many too, especially for those who have lost someone beloved by them. God and His Church want to remind us at this time of year that we are never alone and are always able to reach out for timely help. I have been reading Fr. Don Calloway's autobiography, called *No Turning Back: A Witness to Mercy*. It's incredibly powerful. What strikes me most is how he caused his family so many problems through his struggles with addiction and accompanying criminal behavior, and yet, they never gave up on him. They did not disown him. They kept forgiving him and giving him another chance. Eventually, through Our Lady he comes home to the Church and Faith and repents. The way he wrote about his parents' love and mercy for him made me think of God's love for me and each of us.

Family is a great mystery! They fill us with the greatest wonder, love, frustration, disappointment,

laughter and mercy – all at the same family party – and, yet, we can't picture life without them. For many families, Fr. Calloway's story hits very close to home; for others, it seems difficult to comprehend. Still, we all know that universal desire of *belonging*. We want to belong, to fit. We want to be greeted with a smile and embrace (even if you're not a hugger ... we all know the truth!). We want someone to listen to us empathetically and just be. We want to have fellowship over a meal together. Many of the most healing and unifying moments of my life have been over sharing a meal and laughter together. This is why the Lord speaks about heaven as an eternal banquet and why heaven is the place of perfect, *communal*, supernatural happiness. This is why the commandments are broken into two groupings: 1-3 about our personal relationship with God and 4-10 about our relationship with our brothers and sisters in the world (i.e., Jesus in disguise). He centered his entire divine economy on the idea of family.

This weekend, December 31, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. We also celebrate the Solemnity (non-obligatory this year) of Mary, Mother of God on Monday, January 1. You, the beloved baptized believer, have been adopted into the Holy Family by God. He "takes ownership" of you, adopts you and says, "you are mine and I love you." You belong in his family. You can find rest for your troubled heart and mind there in his arms in his family (and yours). How are we doing living the graces offered to us to live this relationship with him well? How are we doing reflecting the love of the Holy Family in our families; how in our parish? How do we show the love and sense of belonging to the person sitting next to you or near you in the pew? Ask God for help. He will never abandon you; he will always come with timely help and grace.

Family is a great mystery of love and belonging. No one is too far gone. It's never too late to make amends. Every situation has hope

to be reconciled by courageously approaching the other and saying, "I was wrong about _____; will you please forgive me?" It's on the other person to ask for forgiveness for their part in the rift; your responsibility is to reconcile your part. Can we see that the other is family? Can we see that the other is wounded and hurting and maybe hurt us their woundedness? It doesn't make it okay, but it does help us to find pity for them and, then, mercy. Ask God for help to see what the troubled human heart is unable to see on its own. He will show you the way to tenderness, pity and mercy. Let's let our marriages and families be filled with these words: I love you, thank you, please forgive me (I forgive you), and let's pray. Lean on God and all will be well.

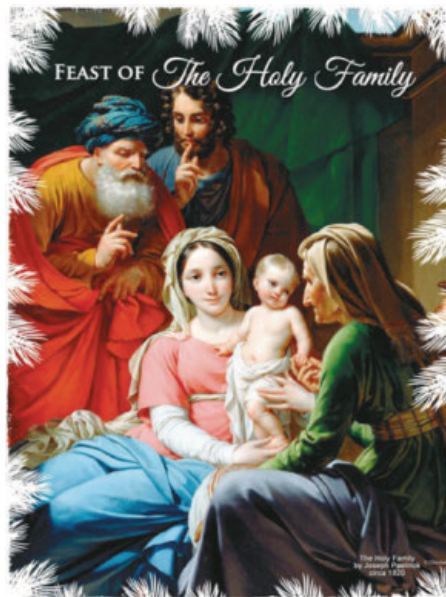

December 31st Holy Family Parish

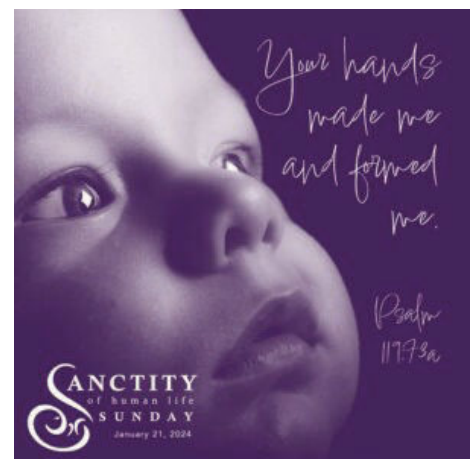

Michigan Green Schools 2024

January 1st always brings a lot of “firsts” into our lives. It is a sign of new beginnings and welcome changes. A new year brings opportunities for growth and improvement that our school and student body embraces in many ways. For instance, tomorrow is the opening day for our application process to once again be considered a Michigan Green School.

Ever since the program began in 2006, St. Augustine School has been granted the honor of being named a Green School. This will be our 18th consecutive year earning this esteemed honor. The overall goal of the Green School program is to promote stewardship-themed activities and information to support environmental education within Michigan schools. This means that teachers and students work throughout the year to reduce/reuse/recycle, conserve energy and protect our environment. Some of the activities we’ve done in the past include adopting an endangered animal, committing

to turning off lights when not being used and recycling unwanted electronics and paper.

This year, the students in middle school made recycling fun. We collected clear plastic containers, decorated them and made cool shrinky-dink backpack tags out of them. The students also used store-bought shrinky dink material to compare the results of new and recycled materials and couldn’t tell the difference. Reusing unwanted materials for a new purpose is a great habit for anyone and some cool things can be created.

This activity will count for just one small part of our commitment to the Michigan Green Schools requirements to be recognized as an environmentally conscious organization. The Green School banner that hangs outside of our school entrance is a reminder that our students value the God-given resources we have and we will continue to take care of all that God has entrusted to us.

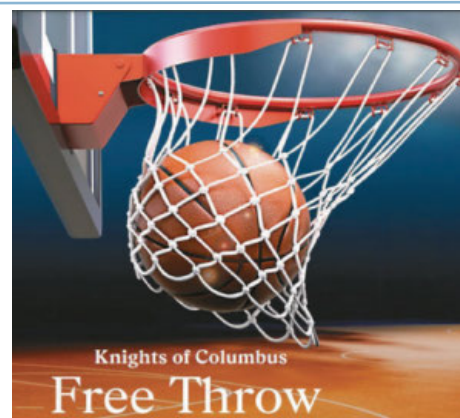
