From Fr. Kishore Beezam

Today, we solemnly celebrate the feast of “The Epiphany of the Lord” and this is the last Sunday of the Christmas season. The word “Epiphany” comes from the Greek word ‘*Epiphania*’ meaning ‘*revelation or manifestation*’.

This feast commemorates the visit of the wise men to worship the baby Jesus. Tradition tells us that their names were **Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar**. The men were astrologers who were looking for the star that would lead them to the promised Messiah. This was prophesied in the Book of Micah. According to the Gospel narratives, the wise men brought gifts of **Gold, Frankincense, and Myrrh** with them. These gifts were very meaningful.

Gold was a precious and expensive gift, and showed how important Jesus was.

Frankincense is a sweet perfume which was often burned in the temple to worship God. It was a sign that Jesus should be worshipped.

Myrrh was used to keep things fresh, and it was used by the women to anoint Jesus’ body when he died. By bringing it as a gift to Jesus, the wise men foretold his suffering and death.

The story of the **Magi** focuses on their long journey seeking the Savior of the

world. They placed their time, talent, and treasure at the service of their mission. Their journey of a thousand miles or more westward from their countries in the East, which could have taken almost three months, is really a symbol of the inward journey they made in their hearts, a journey from paganism to belief in Jesus as the Savior of the world. As a matter of fact, it was a journey of their faith, for it was through the grace of God that the wise men were led to faith in Jesus. Today’s Gospel also tells us the story of the Magi’s encounter with the evil King Herod. This encounter symbolizes three reactions to Jesus’ birth: hatred, indifference, and adoration:

1. A group of people headed by Herod planned to destroy Jesus.
2. Another group, composed of priests and scribes, ignored Jesus.
3. The members of a third group – shepherds and the magi -- adored Jesus and offer themselves to Him. The shepherds offered the only gifts they had: love, tears of joy, and probably woollen clothes and milk from their sheep. The Magi offered gold, in recognition of Jesus as the King of the Jews; frankincense, in acknowledgment that he was God, and myrrh as a symbol of his human nature.

Let us make sure that we belong to the third group: Let us worship Jesus at Mass, every day if we can, with the gold of our love, the myrrh of our humility and the frankincense of our adoration. Let us plot a better course for our lives as the Magi did, choosing for ourselves a better way of life in the New Year by abstaining from proud and impure thoughts, evil habits and selfish behaviour and sharing our love with others in acts of charity.

We can remove or lessen the darkness of the evil around us by being, if not like stars, at least like candles, radiating Jesus’ love by selfless service, unconditional forgiveness, and compassionate care. Let us seek God’s peace in our own lives through prayer, the Sacramental life and daily meditation on the Word of God.

On the Feast of the Epiphany, the three wise men give up their palaces, power, and possessions; they say farewell to the most cherished people in the lives to pursue a deeper calling. And from there, they proceed on one mission, they focus on one star, and it leads them to one stable, where they encounter one person, in whom their wildest dreams are fulfilled.

Today’s feast invites us to focus on the “one thing,” Christ, and that all other pursuits mean nothing in comparison.

When we do finally encounter Christ and refuse to hand him over to any Herod or earthly power, then, we will have become truly wise.

My dear brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ, today (6th of January) my village celebrates the Feast of the Epiphany in a very special way. The bishop comes to celebrate this special mass every year where many children are baptized. Parents often choose baptismal names of the three kings. So likewise, when I was a child, my parents had me baptized on this feast day and gave me the baptismal name Casper Raju Beezam. I kindly ask that you please pray for me, my family, and my villagers on this feast of the Epiphany.

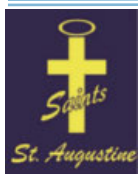

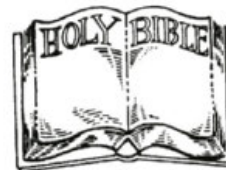

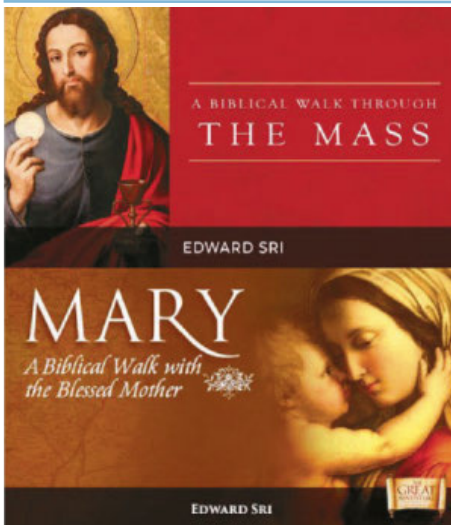

Serving this community has been a blessing and I thank you with all my heart.

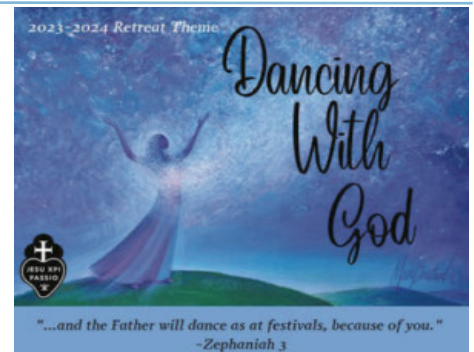

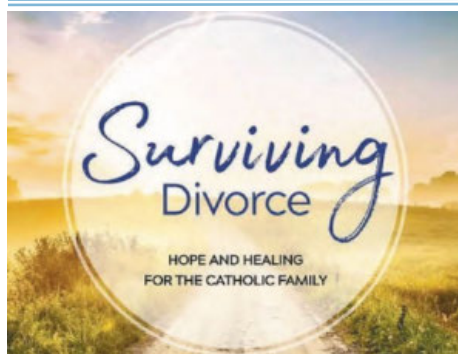
