Contact the parish office for hospital or home visits.

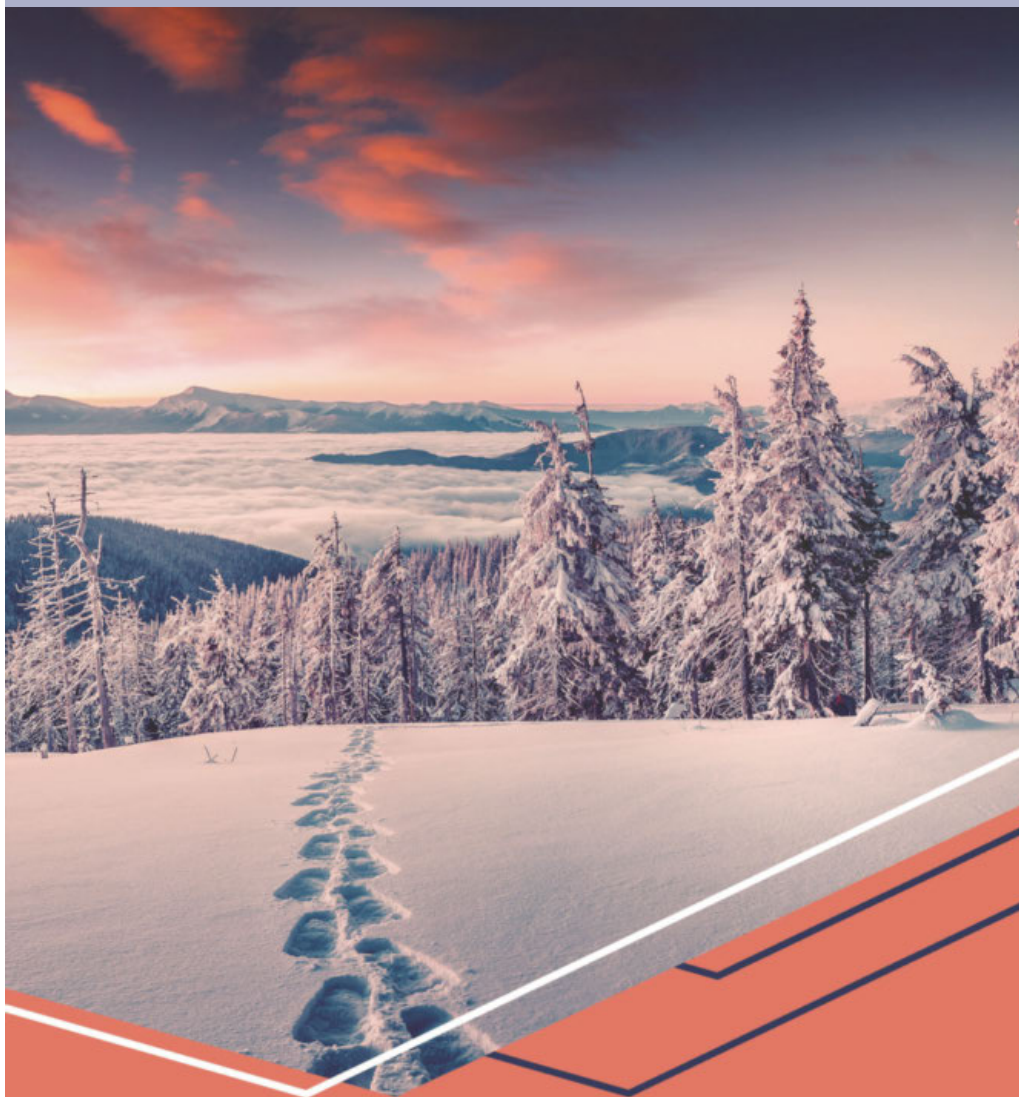

### **From Fr. Mark Livingston**

Happy New Year again to everyone! You continue to be in my prayers, along with Fr. Kishore and our brother deacons.

Sanctity of Life Sunday is approaching next weekend and the March for Life is this Friday, January 19. While the Supreme Court ruling in the 2022 Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization overturned 1973's Roe v. Wade, striking down the nation's *federal* abortion law, the pro-life effort continues into 2024, as the new battle shifts to the *states*. Overturning the federal abortion law was huge. We experienced a surge of hope and promise of the life of the Lord. Now, we are seeing and experiencing the bitter struggle of the ongoing state-by-state battle for life.

Some people, in criticism of us, say that we only focus on eradicating abortion to stand for life, but it is much broader than that, including quality of life, etc. While it is true that every aspect of life has to do with life, it is also supremely true that without quantity of life we can have no quality of life at all. Our country's tenets of "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness" are properly ordered. We cannot confuse "life" (quantity) with "liberty and the

pursuit of happiness" (quality). Every life is sacred. Every person is endowed with the gift of life from God. Who are we to take it away? We are called to stand for both—quantity of life and quality of life—but let's never stop standing firm in the truth and Christian charity for LIFE (quantity), which begins at conception and ends with natural death!

As we enter this week, let's pray for the protection of all human life from conception to natural death. Also, as we all know, we may have done things earlier in life that we regret later in life, including having or supporting abortion. If that applies to you, God's mercy awaits; he desires you to come home through Sacramental Confession and be healed. You are not abandoned or forsaken; he pursues you and sees you as his treasured and beloved son or daughter still. Never forget that. Let's also pray for all victims of abortion (including families) and all who have supported abortion, or participated in one. Jesus' healing and peace is for all. It's why he came.

At this time, I would like to especially and sincerely thank our Knights of Columbus Councils at Holy Family, St. Augustine and St. Mary Mystical

Rose, for being men who lead our Family in the ongoing march for life, to honor the sanctity of all human life from conception to natural death. They have given generously to various pro-life causes, including the Right to Life, Spero Center in Port Huron, and many other centers for life.

The 51st-annual March for Life in Washington, D.C., will be held Friday, January 19, 1 to 4 p.m. **Let's join them by praying the Rosary at our homes or offices sometime during that timeframe.** Next year and beyond, I would love to have a group that travels either to Lansing or Washington to represent our parishes in the March for Life. Will anyone (or a small group of you) please step forward by reaching out to me or one of our offices to volunteer to take on this mission?

## Called to Serve

"When you find yourself waiting on God for answers, do what good waiters do... serve."

I just love when I hear a good quote or phrase from someone, and it's able to resonate both in my mind and in my heart. Words have a way of inspiring us to be better today than what we were yesterday. I was visiting family in Frankenmuth when a beautiful woman named Mary came to administer the Eucharist to one of my family members. During her visit, Mary shared some of Fr. Patrick Jankowiak's homily she heard that morning at mass. His message was simple but yet so powerful: "When you are waiting on God for answers, do what good waiters do....SERVE!" It seems that we spend so much of our lives waiting. Sometimes we are waiting on important things like retirement, test results, a job offer, a new baby, our wedding day, or graduation. Other times our waiting is less important, like standing in line at Kroger, sitting at the doctor's office, or simply waiting for the workday to end.

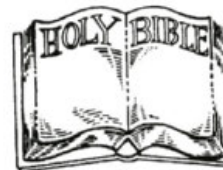
Many times it's during the "waiting" that opportunities to serve God present themselves. Right after our last mass before Christmas Break, my students and I were waiting in the pew for other classes to make their way out. At the

same time the cantor came over to find a student to be a reader during one of the Christmas masses. Just as I thought no one would be able to help out, a sixth grader next to me spoke up and said she could do it. It wasn't until later I thought about the courage it took for this student to step up and serve. She did not know for sure if her family would be at that particular mass, but she must have known they would support her as she did this good deed for Christ. This young lady did not even know what she had to read, but she must have had enough trust in God to know that whatever it was she could do it with confidence! It's in moments like these I am reminded by others that I need to stop waiting for God to make it "perfectly clear" what he wants from me and just serve. To see this in action from one of my students was humbling to say the least.

Let's give thanks to people like our students and Mary, and all those when called to serve, do it! We can spend our whole lives waiting for God to speak to us when He's right there waiting for us—waiting for us to let go of our fear of failure, or fear of missing out on something better we could be doing with our time.

So what are you waiting for? It's in serving Him that we will truly be living our BEST life!

Serving this community has been a blessing and I thank you with all my heart.

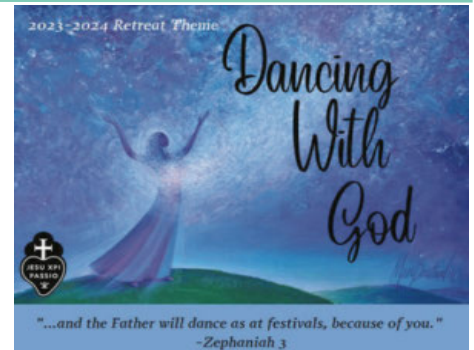
