An Exercise in Patience

I'm starting to lose track of what year our Science Olympiad team is in now, but I'm pretty sure this is our 5th year. How time flies! With each new school year, I look forward to watching how each student progresses from the first practice to the end of the season. Seeing their growth in knowledge and confidence makes the long and challenging road rather fulfilling. Being a part of this team is truly an exercise of patience regardless if you are a student or a coach. I'm thankful to say that since Science Olympiad started up 5 years ago, our whole team has exhibited an almost God-like level of patience with themselves and each other while learning new things, navigating the challenges that arise during this process, and accepting tournament results at the end of the season regardless of the outcome. While the students (and us coaches) may not realize it, this exercise of patience points us towards something even greater.

Having the patience, and most especially, trust in the Lord as we try to persevere through any trial, big or small, helps prepare us for our eternal life in heaven. It can be a difficult concept to grasp, but thankfully our Lord gives us plenty of examples in His great saints. Our team's patron, St. Joseph, is a prime example and it's no surprise that he bears the title "Mirror of Patience." In his book, *Consecration to St. Joseph: The Wonders of Our Spiritual Father*, Fr. Don Calloway explains that St. Joseph's patience was tested in abundance from all of the trials he had to endure throughout his life. From learning that his holy spouse Mary had suddenly conceived a child without his involvement, to taking his family to Egypt to escape Herod, to providing for them with very little

means, to losing the Child Jesus for three days in Jerusalem, St. Joseph never acted imprudently despite the many anxieties he likely had in these situations. Instead, St. Joseph waited upon the Lord to reveal His plan and only then acted accordingly, having complete trust in Divine Providence. This patience, among many other virtues, ultimately helped prepare St. Joseph for his place in heaven, one that Fr. Calloway states, along with many saints including some Doctors of the Church, is after the Blessed Virgin Mary but above all the other saints. If St. Joseph had the patience to persevere through such hardships, his example should provide great comfort and encouragement for us when we are faced with our own trials.

In that same spirit, our team prays together before the start of every practice, asking for St. Joseph's intercession and God's blessings on the team. This year, the students took some time to get to know St. Joseph a little better through some guided research before writing a prayer specific to our team's needs. What they came up with will surely impress you and remind each of us that we should approach our Lord with the simplicity and sincerity of children, while also having the patience to wait for the Lord's answer.
