From Fr. Mark Livingston

This is the time of year, when we don't see a lot of sun, that things can begin to feel kind of heavy. The cold, grey stagnation has been lingering for a while now. We might even start to isolate ourselves more from others. We might even start to think, especially if we are sick, that we are not worth much if we can't do much. Jesus calls us out of the darkness of heaviness, depression, anxiety, fear, and even sickness, into his marvelous light. Henri Nouwen wrote a chapter ("From Action to Passion") in a book called *From Bread and Wine: Readings for Lent and Easter*, in which he recounts an encounter with a sick man that he visited who was struggling with this very thing. After the man told him that he was struggling to feel of any worth and asked him for some advice, Henri reflects on the idea that we can start to think of ourselves as only being worth what we are doing. While it is very important to do things in life—whatever you can do—to serve the Lord, it is also true that a lot of life is responding well to what happens to us.

In a brilliant, prayerful writing, Henri remembers that Jesus' life teaches us that "all action (working) ends in passion" (that is, passivity, or receiving and not acting) and often the conditions of life become out of our hands to effect change. Jesus took action in his life by raising people from the dead, curing sickness, healing people, preaching the Good News, and many other things. Then, he was "handed over" and becomes "one to whom things are being done. He is betrayed, arrested, scourged, crowned with thorns and crucified. What did he do? He accepted this "passion" with patience, trust, waiting and receptivity.

Henri reminds us that when Jesus said, "It is finished," he did not mean "I have done all the things I wanted to do," but also, "I have allowed things to be done to me that needed to be done to me in order for me to fulfill my vocation." Wow! How many of us receive the difficult things that happen to us with the same grace, virtue and charity as Jesus. No, we often fight, argue and commit

other sins in our struggle of going through something against our will.

As we wind down Ordinary Time (for now) and start to prepare for Lent, let's ask ourselves, "What is God's will in my current struggle? What might he be wanting to teach me? How does he want me to act in my current 'passion'? What is he asking me to do with it?" He is asking you and me to learn and grow, to offer it united to his cross for the salvation of souls, and to pray for others. This is how he handled it. This is how he calls us to handle it. As we begin to see the light breaking through the toughest part of Winter, take care of yourself, reach out to others for Christian and family community, pray more, and receive whatever you have been "handed over to" for the sake of the Kingdom of God.

The Lord loves you and I do, too!
