It seems that no matter which race, creed, or nationality, we belong to, we all have something in common. That is the desire to find someone we want to spend the rest of our lives with. This Sunday we celebrate World Marriage Day.

I remember as a young child my grandmother telling me at a family wedding to pray for the girl I was going to marry. When I was in high school, the subject came up again. She reminded me to pray for my wife, and this time we had an actual conversation about what she meant. She told me that like everything else in my life, God has a plan. While I may not have known in the moment who I was going to marry, I knew that God had a plan. In a weird way that made sense to me, so I began to pray for my wife. It wasn't until many years later that I finally met her, and I knew very quickly that she was "the one." It's funny how God works!

Obviously, like everything else in life, marriage is not easy. We know that the divorce rate for

Catholics is only slightly less than that of the rest of the population. However, when we have the mindset to allow God to be a central part of marriage, He rarely disappoints.

God is Love. It's the simplest yet most powerful definition of who God is. He is Love. If we truly believe this, then to try to live with another human being in marriage and not depend on God's intervention, we will struggle much more than we need to.

I tell the engaged couples I work with that they need to sit down together every single day, even if it's for only five minutes, and share with each other their day. But before they begin, they have to invite God to their discussion.

I let them know that God will abundantly bless them, because that is exactly what He wants, to be a part of their marriage. After they are done sharing, they need to thank God for being with them that day. A daily conversation will allow them to share what

they are feeling and how things are going. They have to listen attentively to one another and solve all the little problems before they become big problems. In this way the marriage stays on track, and nothing is left unsaid. One of the big problems in marriage is that we stop talking and listening to one another. That is a recipe for disaster!

It was not a coincidence that Jesus' first miracle took place at a wedding at the request of his mother! A good and holy marriage is one of the greatest blessings of life, but it does not come easily. It takes daily effort, it takes prayer, and it takes God.

This Wednesday Lent begins as we receive ashes on our foreheads. This outward sign of our humanity reminds us of how fragile life is. Let us recommit ourselves this Lenten season to our belief and trust in God, our faithful commitment to one another, and the love that we all share.

Who Are We to Judge?

The fourth grade students are reading the book titled *Because of Winn Dixie*. Without giving too much away, it's about a girl named Opal that moves to a new town with her preacher father. Her mother left them when Opal was three years old. The girl has a feeling of loneliness until she comes across a stray dog. She decides (with her father's permission) to keep him and the dog helps her make friends in town.

In this story, the people Opal meets can all be judged based on one thing or another like: what others say about someone else, their looks, age, current behavior, or past mistakes. The beauty of this book is that Opal was able to look past these imperfections with Winn-Dixie's help. In doing so, the story ends with Opal having made many friends.

Nobody is perfect. We were born with original sin and we were given free will to make our own choices whether good or bad. We all make mistakes and hopefully we learn from them. In the story, the character Gloria Dump has a tree she calls the "mistake tree". She hangs bottles from the tree and tells Opal that the bottles are symbols of bad things she did in the past. Opal can't believe that Gloria did all those bad things because Gloria is the nicest person she's known. Opal practiced openness when meeting Gloria and therefore they became dear friends. If Opal was to judge her based on the past, she would have missed out on a great friendship.

There are many verses in the Bible that tell us not to judge others. In John 7:24 it says, "Do not judge by appearances, but judge with right judgment." Luke 6:37 states, "Judge not, and you will not be judged;

condemn not, and you will not be condemned; forgive, and you will be forgiven;" Romans 2: 1-3 tells us, "Therefore you have no excuse, O man, whoever you are, when you judge another; for in passing judgment upon him you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, are doing the very same things. We know that the judgment of God rightly falls upon those who do such things. Do you suppose, O man, that when you judge those who do such things and yet do them yourself, you will escape the judgment of God?" There are more verses in the Bible that I'm not going to list. The point is that we are not to judge others.

When we hold back from judging others, it opens up possibilities of friendship, compassion, love, and openness. I love the quotes from Saint Mother Teresa. They are simply said, but yet they are very profound. Saint Mother Teresa once said, "If you judge people, you have no time to love them." She saw Jesus in the poor that she served. She said, "I see Jesus in every human being. I say to myself, this is hungry Jesus, I must feed him. This is sick Jesus. This one has leprosy or gangrene; I must wash him and tend to him. I serve because I love Jesus." We can use Saint Mother Teresa as an example and practice seeing Christ Jesus in others.

In the story *Because of Winn-Dixie*, Opal has her dog to help her look past others' imperfections. In doing so, she has great friends and doesn't feel lonely anymore. We have Jesus. With His help we can look past the imperfections of others too. In doing so, we can strive to be more like the saints and be more like Jesus
