

#### From Fr. Mark Livingston

Lent is underway! We are off and running—with great reverence and love for the Lord and his people, our brothers and sisters. In this holy season of Lent, the Lord calls us to live the liturgy! I remember when I was discerning priesthood and religious life, I traveled around the country looking for the right fit for a community. One Community, The Community of the Beatitudes, made this the charism of their group.

In the Liturgy, the full Paschal Mystery is celebrated—Christ's life, passion, death and resurrection. "The life of the victim is in the blood," as the Book of Leviticus tells us. In the Mass, Jesus' Body and Blood are separated in different vessels, which recalls and renders present his life offered once for all for the forgiveness of sins. He is "lifted up" in the elevation of the sacred species for our healing and help (John 3:14 and Numbers 21). At the fractioning on the altar (while most are exchanging peace to one another), the priest breaks a piece of the host (Body) and places it into the chalice (Blood) which is the moment of resurrection in the Mass, when Body and Blood are reunited and life returns! then consume the crucified and risen Lord and are filled with his glory. Then, we are called to "go forth" as we are sent into the world to be a living Tabernacle (vessel of the Real

Presence of the Lord) to be a light to/in the world.

We live the liturgy by remembering and practicing the Paschal Mystery each week. Thursday, we might pray for priests and pray before the Blessed Sacrament, as we recall the Last Supper and the institution of the Eucharist. We typically pray the Luminous Mysteries on that day to remember this, the greatest of all gifts from God. On Fridays, we might fast from something, including meat to recall Jesus' passion and death; we might pray the Sorrowful Mysteries and spend time with the Lord in prayer and thanksgiving. On Saturdays, we await with home and expectation the Resurrection of the Lord on Saturday evening and Sunday and pray the Joyful Mysteries on Saturday! We might pray the Glorious Mysteries on Sunday! There are many things that can be done but, most importantly, we should pray, offer sacrifices or penances (fasting, volunteering, etc.), and give alms to support the Church and/or other charitable causes. Each of these are things asked from us by the Lord in scripture for our growth and freedom.

This Lent, as we begin, let's go forward together and live the liturgy in our lives!
