I hope you are having a great week and weekend. You are precious to the Lord and to me. We are one week from Holy Week! In our Gospel this weekend we hear an interesting dialogue between Jesus and the Father. Jesus calls to the Father to "glorify his name." The Father responds by saying, "I have glorified it [in the Nativity] and will glorify it again [in the Paschal Mystery]."

Palm Sunday, the beginning of the week in which the Father will be glorified again, is right around the corner. Along with Christmas, Holy Week is the most special and liturgically unique time in our Church calendar. There will be many opportunities to worship the Lord and engage in prayer with the Lord's Passion, death and resurrection in our parishes.

First, we will celebrate Palm Sunday together at all parishes in the normal Mass schedule. This will be a beautiful time for us, to prepare our hearts, minds and souls for the week ahead, and to make the way for the Lord, by crying out, "Hosanna!" The

Lord has entered the holy city to accomplish the purpose for which he was sent — our salvation.

Then, the Mass of the Lord's Supper is the only Mass celebrated on Holy Thursday. This will be celebrated at two of our parishes, at which we will present the holy oils that we used for confirmation and baptism, for welcoming people into the church, and for helping the sick heal. At this same Mass, feet will be washed, and the institution of the Eucharist will be celebrated. After Mass, we will process together to the Altar of Repose and have the opportunity to adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament until midnight. We do this because this Mass and evening commemorates the Lord's Supper and his prayer in Gethsemane. Jesus said to his disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Will you stay with me and pray for one hour?" Consider staying with Jesus to pray for a period of time during the night.

On Good Friday, we commemorate the Lord's passion in many ways in our parishes, with prayer and devotions in our church, starting at noon and ending at around 5 PM. The capstone of that afternoon is the 3 PM celebration of liturgy of the Lord's passion. Please consider attending for this wonderful Liturgy.

On the evening of Good Friday. we will celebrate a unique and absolutely beautiful liturgy called Tenebrae. Tenebrae means "darkness," and it's meant to commemorate the darkness of having the Lord of glory taken from us. It asks us to recall that the light of the world has been temporarily taken away until he rises again in a few days. This celebration takes place a little later than many are used to, but you will not be disappointed. We will pray Psalms together and rest in progressive darkness under candlelight. This will take place at Holy Family in the evening. Please check the schedule.

On Holy Saturday, we will start the day with morning prayer, blessing of Easter baskets, and an Easter egg hunt at St. Mary Mystical Rose in the morning. Please come to this! This is a great time for us, as we await the resurrection of Jesus as he lays in the tomb, to be together as a family of faith to support one another and pray.

Later on Holy Saturday, we will celebrate the Easter Vigil at

Saint Augustine. We will have representatives from each parish reading and participating in the liturgy. We will welcome several new members of the church, though there are many more in formation. This is one of the most beautiful and ancient liturgies that's done by candlelight for a large portion of it, including several readings, and the initiation of catechumens and candidates into the Church. We begin at 8:30 PM.

This is a very special time. Please take a nap and drink some coffee to participate in everything you're able to participate in! We tend to be a community of early risers, but this week is special and different. Let's join together in these later evening celebrations to really experience the joy and beauty of this season with Jesus and His Bride, the Church.

Lastly, we celebrate the resurrection of the Lord on Easter Sunday. You can find the adjusted Mass schedule in the bulletin, and in the mailing that was sent to you. Each parish will have two Easter morning Masses.

I can't wait to celebrate Holy Week with you and all of the beauties that come with it. I feel so blessed to be here with you. Let's come together with the Lord and his whole divine economy and pray. See you in Church!

A Recent Incident at Church and Our Safety

This past weekend at one of our Masses, the police were called because of a suspicious character in the front pew. This person was escorted out by law enforcement (due to concerning behaviors) at the time of the intercessions. I want everyone who has heard of this to be at peace. I know this man from Shrine of the Little Flower, my previous parish. He has issues and I was unaware that he was coming to visit me. Be assured that when the police searched him, they found no weapons. Given his condition and large stature he can seem threatening. I have taken all the proper precautions with the Archdiocese of Detroit and law enforcement to ensure that this will not happen again.

You are safe. Be at peace about attending Mass safely at our parishes and worshiping God together as a family in Faith.






