CORL Statement on the Death of George Floyd

The Book of Ecclesiastes teaches us, “There is a time to be silent and a time to speak out.” We of different faiths cannot remain silent after we watched the shattering video of a police officer keeping his knee on the neck of George Floyd who was crying out “I can’t breathe.” Such inhumane treatment of another human being requires a collective response from all people of conscience. The pursuit of justice is a fundamental tenet of our respective religious traditions, and thus we stand together to declare that all life is sacred, and all people are equal before the law in a democratic society.

We respect those who want to honor George Floyd’s memory with peaceful protest against the horror, evil, and sin that is racism. We also support the members of Floyd’s family who said, in part, “We cannot endanger each other as we respond to the necessary urge to raise our voices in unison and in outrage. Looting and violence distract from the strength of our collective voice.”

We often speak of “thoughts and prayers.” We will offer our many prayers of healing, but we need not only serious thoughts but also firm action as we work together with all members of our community to find that critical cure for human hatred.

Declaración de CORL sobre la muerte de George Floyd

El Libro del Eclesiastés nos enseña: "Hay un tiempo para callar y un tiempo para hablar". Nosotros, de diferentes religiones, no podemos permanecer en silencio después de ver el video demoledor de un oficial de policía manteniendo su rodilla sobre el cuello de George Floyd que gritaba "No puedo respirar". Tal trato inhumano de otro ser humano requiere una respuesta colectiva de todas las personas de conciencia. La búsqueda de la justicia es un principio fundamental de nuestras respectivas tradiciones religiosas y, por lo tanto, nos unimos para declarar que toda vida es sagrada y que todas las personas son iguales ante la ley en una sociedad democrática.

Respetamos a aquellos que quieren honrar la memoria de George Floyd con una protesta pacífica contra el horror, el mal y el pecado que es el racismo. También apoyamos a los miembros de la familia de Floyd que dijeron, en parte, "No podemos ponernos en peligro el uno al otro al responder al impulso necesario de alzar nuestras voces al unísono e indignación". El saqueo y la violencia distraen de la fuerza de nuestra voz colectiva."

A menudo hablamos de "pensamientos y oraciones". Ofreceremos nuestras muchas oraciones de sanación, pero no solo necesitamos pensamientos serios sino también acciones firmes a medida que trabajamos junto con todos los miembros de nuestra comunidad para encontrar esa cura crítica para el odio humano.

- ✠ All Masses are suspended until further notice. Masses will be televised on the Catholic Faith Network (Optimum Channel 29/137, Verizon FiOS TV 296, & Spectrum 162/471) and available online at: **www.catholicfaithnetwork.org/ or www.saintpatrickscathedral.org/live.**
 - ✠ People who devoutly attend the liturgy according to the indications of the Church, at the moment of receiving the Eucharist, pray to God, you will receive it spiritually. Communion can only be given as viaticum.
 - ✠ Our church will open for personal prayer, Monday-Saturday 9 a.m.-12 noon, Sunday 8 a.m.-2 p.m. Intentions previously made for masses will be offered privately by the priests. Grotto open 9 a.m. - 7 p.m. everyday.
 - ✠ The religious education program will remain suspended.
 - ✠ These restrictions include rescheduling Confirmation, First Communion, First Confessions, etc.
 - ✠ Catholic Elementary Schools in the Archdiocese of NY will remain closed to the end of the school year.
 - ✠ Baptisms, weddings, funerals have been suspended during this time. In regard to funerals, please have your funeral director contact us.
 - ✠ Confessions can be heard with caution at a distance of 6 feet.
 - ✠ We will continue to administer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick as needed with possible restrictions
 - ✠ Pastoral care over the phone is available.
 - ✠ As this emergency situation evolves, we will update the instructions we receive from the Archdiocese. But the important thing is to use the means wisely and not to be infected with fear and even less with panic, but rather to trust in the divine providence of our Heavenly Father.

- ✠ Todas las Misas se suspenden hasta nuevo aviso. Serán televisados en Catholic Faith Network (Canal Optimum 29/137, Verizon FiOS TV, 296, y Spectrum, 162/471) y disponibles en línea en: **www.catholicfaithnetwork.org/ o www.saintpatrickscathedral.org/live.**
 - ✠ Las personas que atiendan con devoción la liturgia según las indicaciones de la Iglesia y en el momento de recibir la Eucaristía, oren a Dios, lo recibirán espiritualmente. La comunión solo se puede dar como viático.
 - ✠ Nuestra iglesia abre para la oración personal, de lunes a sábado de 9 a.m. a 12 del mediodía, domingo de 8 a.m. a 2 p.m. Las intenciones de las Misas que hagan los fieles se ofrecerán privadamente por los sacerdotes. La Gruta abre de 9 a.m. a 7 p.m. todos los días.
 - ✠ El programa de educación religiosa permanecen suspendido.
 - ✠ Estas restricciones incluyen la reprogramación de confirmaciones, primeras comuniones, primeras confesiones, etc.
 - ✠ Las escuelas primarias católicas en la Arquidiócesis de NY permanecerá cerrado hasta el final del año escolar.
 - ✠ Bautizos, bodas, funerales han sido suspendidos durante este tiempo. Con respecto a los funerales, haga que su director de funerales se comuniquen con nosotros.
 - ✠ Las confesiones pueden escucharse con prudencia a una distancia de 6 pies.
 - ✠ Continuaremos administrando el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos según sea necesario con posibles restricciones
 - ✠ La atención pastoral por teléfono esta totalmente disponible.
 - ✠ A medida que vaya evolucionando esta situación de emergencia, iremos actualizando las indicaciones que recibimos de la Arquidiócesis. Pero lo importante es poner los medios con prudencia y no contagiarse del miedo y menos del pánico, sino confiar en la divina providencia de nuestro Padre Celestial.

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
