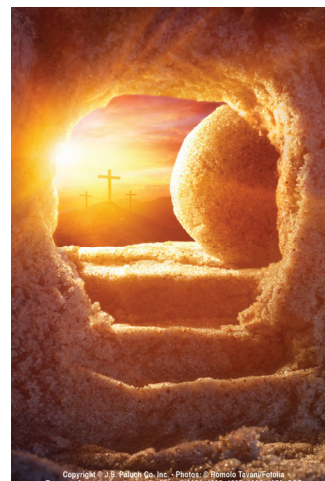

## *Message from Father Robert:*

In his commentary on the Acts of the Apostles St. John Chrysostom writes, “To many persons this Book is so little known, both it and its author, that they are not even aware that there is such a book in existence. For this reason especially I have taken this narrative for my subject, that I may draw to it such as do not know it, and not let such a treasure as this remain hidden out of sight.” What St. John Chrysostom said in the third century can be true today. The reason why is because during the Easter Season the Church reads from the Acts of the Apostles at almost every Mass, and very rarely from it outside the Easter Season. Even though it is read throughout this joyful time, it can be easily overlooked; and since latter half of it beginning at chapter 13 deals with the works of St. Paul one can get easily lost (in a good way) in what he said and did.

What we know of the Acts of the Apostles is that the author is anonymous; however, tradition holds that it author is St. Luke since the just as in the Gospel he dedicates the Acts to “Theophilus” among other things as concern for the sick (St. Luke was said to be a physician) as well as being part of St. Paul’s missionary team with the use of the word “we” in certain parts of Acts that kind of identifies himself. Interestingly, St. Paul mentions this in his letter to Philemon as he writes “Epaphras, my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus, sends greetings to you, and so do Mark, Aristarchus, Demas, and Luke, my fellow coworkers.” (Philem, 24) He also mentions St. Luke as being a physician (Col 4:14). Scholars believe the dating of this book is sometime between the 60s to 80s A.D., some of them propose possibly around 63 A.D. which would have been the time of St. Paul’s house arrest in Rome. Next week, more will be said in regards to the structure and themes in regards to this great book.

If anyone took up reading the Bible during Lent, loved it, and would like to continue it, might I suggest taking up reading the Acts of the Apostles during Easter Season. I hope you will find a unique joy in reading those 28 chapters, in many ways the Acts of the Apostles is perhaps one of the best action adventure stories ever told because it recounts how the Church spread the Gospel in its very first days with all its ups and downs. Even in the beginning of Acts with the words of Christ “but you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth,” (Acts 1:8) we are given a hint of the things to come. May God give us the strength and fortitude of the Apostles to proclaim the Good News and always keeps us in the joy of the Resurrection.



## *Mensaje del Padre Robert:*

En su comentario sobre los Hechos de los Apóstoles San Juan Crisóstomo escribe: "Para muchas personas este Libro es tan poco conocido, tanto él como su autor, que ni siquiera son conscientes de que existe tal libro. Por esta razón especialmente he tomado esta narrativa para mi tema, para que pueda dibujar a ella como no lo sé, y no dejar que un tesoro como este permanezca oculto fuera de la vista." Lo que San Juan Crisóstomo dijo en el siglo III puede ser cierto hoy en día. La razón es porque durante la Época de Pascua la Iglesia lee de los Hechos de los Apóstoles en casi todas las misas, y muy raramente de ella fuera de la Temporada de Pascua. A pesar de que se lee a lo largo de este tiempo alegre, se puede pasar fácilmente por alto; y como la segunda mitad de ella a partir del capítulo 13 se ocupa de las obras de San Pablo uno puede perderse fácilmente (en el buen sentido) en lo que dijo e hizo.

Lo que sabemos de los Hechos de los Apóstoles es que el autor es anónimo; sin embargo, la tradición sostiene que el autor es San Lucas, ya que al igual que en el Evangelio dedica los Hechos a "Teófilo", entre otras cosas, como preocupación por los enfermos (se decía que San Lucas era médico) así como formar parte del equipo misionero de San Pablo con el uso de la palabra "nosotros" en ciertas partes de hechos que se identifican a sí mismo. Curiosamente, San Pablo menciona esto en su carta a Filemón mientras escribe "Epaphras, mi compañero prisionero en Cristo Jesús, te envía saludos, al igual que Mark, Aristarchus, Demas y Luke, mis compañeros de trabajo". (Philem, 24) También menciona a San Lucas como médico (Col 4, 14). Los eruditos creen que la datación de este libro es en algún momento entre los años 60 y 80 d.C., algunos de ellos proponen posiblemente alrededor del año 63 d.C., que habría sido el momento del arresto domiciliario de San Pablo en Roma. La próxima semana se dirán más sobre la estructura y los temas con respecto a este gran libro.

Si alguien tomara la lectura de la Biblia durante la Cuaresma, la amó y quisiera continuarla, quisiera sugerirme que tomara la lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles durante la Pascua. Espero que encuentren un gozo único al leer esos 28 capítulos, en muchos sentidos los Hechos de los Apóstoles es quizás uno de los mejores relatos de aventuras de acción jamás contados porque relata cómo la Iglesia difundió el Evangelio en sus primeros días con todos sus altibajos. Aun al principio de Los Hechos con las palabras de Cristo "pero recibirás poder cuando el Espíritu Santo haya venido sobre ti; y ustedes serán mis testigos en Jerusalén y en toda Judea y Samaria y hasta el fin de la tierra", (Hechos 1:8) se nos da una pista de las cosas venideras. Que Dios nos dé la fuerza y la fortaleza de los apóstoles para proclamar la Buena Nueva y siempre nos mantenga en la alegría de la Resurrección.
