

Walk-Up Vaccinations for People 50+

New Yorkers age 50 and older plus one accompanying eligible person of any age can now get vaccinated together without appointments at select vaccination sites. Proof of age and eligibility is required upon arrival at the vaccination site. A full list of vaccination sites accepting walk-up appointments can be found at on.nyc.gov/WalkUpSites

COVID-19 Care and Vaccine Access Factsheets

COVID-19 vaccines are free to anyone living in the U.S. HRSA has published two new <u>factsheets</u> to address concerns about barriers some immigrants face regarding documentation requests prior to receiving COVID-19 vaccination, and individuals wrongly being sent bills for COVID-19 vaccination. These factsheets are meant to assist patients (<u>English</u> | <u>Spanish</u>) and providers (<u>English</u> | <u>Spanish</u>) understand their rights and responsibilities pertaining to the COVID-19 vaccine access.

Hosting a COVID-19 Vaccination Site

- Indoor buildings of at least 5,000 square feet
- ADA accessible
- Easily accessible by public transportation
- Available for the next 4-6 months

Provided with clinical staff approved to vaccinate
