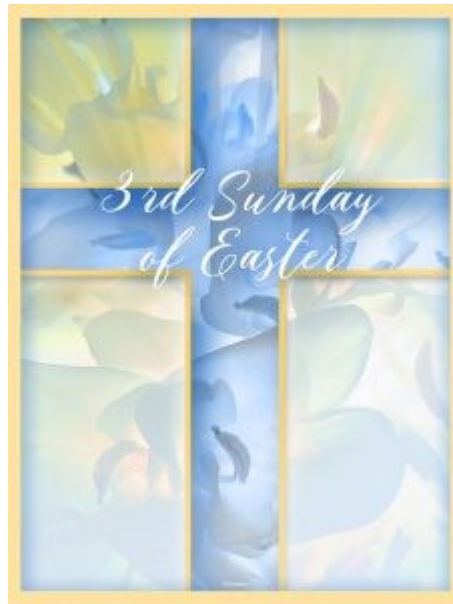

**The state mask mandate for businesses has been lifted by Governor Hochul,
However the following guidelines must still be followed for places of worship:**

- Mask requirements in church are lifted for everyone;
those who wish to continue to wear mask may do so at their discretion;
- Presiders and deacons take note: do not invite the faithful to exchange the sign of peace;
and avoid any physical contact, especially during the homemade 'blessings' of children and adults
 - Concelebrants will communicate from the chalice by intinction only;
 - The Precious Blood will not be offered to the faithful;
- Continue to encourage your communicants to receive in the open hand rather than on the tongue;
- The use of hand sanitizer before and after the distribution of holy communion is a prudent practice;
 - Holy water stoups and baptismal fonts should still remain empty



**El gobernador Hochul levantó el mandato estatal de mascararas para negocios,
Sin embargo, se deben seguir las siguientes pautas para los iglesias:**

- Se eliminan los requisitos de máscara en la iglesia para todos;
aquellos que deseen continuar usando mascarilla podrán hacerlo a su discreción;
- Presbíteros y diáconos tomen nota: no inviten a los fieles a intercambiar el signo de la paz;
y evite cualquier contacto físico, especialmente durante las "bendiciones" caseras de niños y adultos
 - Los concelebrantes se comunicarán desde el cáliz únicamente por intinción;
 - La Preciosa Sangre no será ofrecida a los fieles;
- Continúe alentando a sus comulgantes a recibir con la mano abierta en lugar de con la lengua;
- El uso de desinfectante para manos antes y después de la distribución de la sagrada comunión es una práctica prudente;
 - Las pilas de agua bendita y las pilas bautismales aún deben permanecer vacías
