**The Importance of
Eucharistic Adoration**

The importance of Eucharistic Adoration is shown in the fact that the Church has a ritual that regulates it: the Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. This is an extension of the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which occurs in every Mass: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for Communion with Christ and the rest of the Church. The Rite concludes with the ordained minister blessing the faithful with the Blessed Sacrament. Some important prayers that are used during this rite include the Anima Christi and the Tantum Ergo.

Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica Párrafo 691

"Espíritu Santo" es el nombre propio de aquel a quien adoramos y Glorificamos con el Padre y el Hijo. La Iglesia ha recibido este nombre del Señor y lo profesa en el Bautismo de sus nuevos niños. El término "Espíritu" traduce la palabra hebrea ruah, que, en su sentido primario, significa aliento, aire, viento. Jesús usa la imagen sensorial del viento para sugerir a Nicodemo la novedad trascendente de aquel que es personalmente el aliento de Dios, el Espíritu divino. Por otro lado, "Espíritu" y "Santo" son atributos divinos comunes a las tres personas divinas. Al unir los dos términos, la Escritura, la liturgia y el lenguaje teológico designan a la persona inexpresable del Espíritu Santo, sin ningún posible equívoco con otros usos de los términos "espíritu" y "santo".

La importancia de la Adoración Eucarística

La importancia de la Adoración Eucarística se muestra en el hecho de que la Iglesia tiene un ritual que lo regula: el rito de la Exposición y Bendición Eucarística. Esta es una extensión de la adoración del Santísimo Sacramento que se produce en cada misa: "He aquí el Cordero de Dios, he aquí lo que quita los pecados del mundo Bienaventurados los que son llamados a la cena del Cordero.". Exposición del Santísimo Sacramento fluye desde el sacrificio de la misa y sirve para profundizar nuestra hambre de comunión con Cristo y el resto de la Iglesia. El rito concluye con el ministro ordenado bendecir a los fieles con el Santísimo Sacramento.

Algunas oraciones importantes que se utilizan durante este rito incluyen el Alma de Cristo y el Tantum ergo .

Catechism of the Catholic Church Paragraph 691

"Holy Spirit" is the proper name of the one whom we adore and glorify with the Father and the Son. The Church has received this name from the Lord and professes it in the Baptism of her new children. The term "Spirit" translates the Hebrew word *ruah*, which, in its primary sense, means breath, air, wind. Jesus indeed uses the sensory image of the wind to suggest to Nicodemus the transcendent newness of him who is personally God's breath, the divine Spirit. On the other hand, "Spirit" and "Holy" are divine attributes common to the three divine persons. By joining the two terms, Scripture, liturgy, and theological language designate the inexpressible person of the Holy Spirit, without any possible equivocation with other uses of the terms "spirit" and "holy."

Nicodemus said to him, "How can a person once grown old be born again? Surely he cannot reenter his mother's womb and be born again, can he?" Jesus answered, "Amen, amen, I say to you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit. What is born of flesh is flesh and what is born of spirit is spirit. Do not be amazed that I told you, 'You must be born from above.'
