

Make no mistake, abortion-on-demand is not a right granted by the Constitution. No serious scholar, including one disposed to agree with the Court's result, has argued that the framers of the Constitution intended to create such a right. Shortly after the Roe v. Wade decision, Professor John Hart Ely, now Dean of Stanford Law School, wrote that the opinion "is not constitutional law and gives almost no sense of an obligation to try to be." Nowhere do the plain words of the Constitution even hint at a "right" so sweeping as to permit abortion up to the time the child is ready to be born. Yet that is what the Court ruled. As an act of "raw judicial power" (to use Justice White's biting phrase), the decision by the seven-man majority in Roe v. Wade has so far been made to stick. But the Court's decision has by no means settled the debate. Instead, Roe v. Wade has become a continuing prod to the conscience of the nation." -- President Ronald Reagan, in his book Abortion and the Conscience of the Nation (1983). Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of the Unborn

January 22, 2019

The over 56 million abortions since the 1973 decisions of *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton* reflect with heartbreakingly magnitude what Pope Francis means by a "throwaway culture." However, we have great trust in God's providence. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord's help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal, no. 373, designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance:

"In all the Dioceses of the USA, January 22 shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through abortion."

As individuals, we are called to observe this day through the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and/or giving alms.

A great prayer for life is urgently needed, a prayer which will rise up throughout the world. Through special initiatives and in daily prayer, may an impassioned plea rise to God, the Creator and lover of life, from every Christian community, from every group and association, from every family and from the heart of every believer.

Ningún erudito serio, incluso uno dispuesto a estar de acuerdo con el resultado de la Corte, ha argumentado que los redactores de la Constitución pretendían crear tal derecho. Poco después de la decisión de *Roe v. Wade*, el profesor John Hart Ely, ahora decano de la Facultad de Derecho de Stanford, escribió que la opinión "no es una ley constitucional y casi no tiene sentido de obligación de tratar de ser". En ninguna parte las palabras sencillas de la Constitución incluso sugieren un "derecho" tan amplio que permita el aborto hasta el momento en que el niño está listo para nacer. Sin embargo, eso es lo que dictaminó la Corte. Como un acto de "poder judicial crudo" (para usar la frase mordaz de Justice White), la decisión de la mayoría de siete hombres en *Roe v. Wade* se ha hecho hasta ahora para pegarse. Pero la decisión de la Corte no ha resuelto el debate. En su lugar, *Roe v. 22 de Enero, 2019
