The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, he wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

A - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

B - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

This message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. Even before her death in 1938, the devotion to The Divine Mercy had begun to spread.

Y, él quiere que reconozcamos que Su misericordia es más grande que nuestros pecados, de modo que lo invocaremos con confianza, recibiremos su misericordia y la transmitiremos a otros a través de nosotros. Por lo tanto, todos vendrán a compartir su alegría. El mensaje de la Divina Misericordia es uno que podemos recordar simplemente recordando ABC:

A - Pide Su Misericordia. Dios quiere que nos acerquemos a Él en oración constantemente, arrepintiéndonos de nuestros pecados y pidiéndole que derrame Su misericordia sobre nosotros y sobre el mundo entero.

B - Se misericordioso. Dios quiere que recibamos Su misericordia y que fluya a través de nosotros hacia los demás. Él quiere que extendamos el amor y el perdón a los demás tal como lo hace con nosotros.

C - Confía completamente en Jesús. Dios quiere que sepamos que las gracias de Su misericordia dependen de nuestra confianza. Mientras más confiemos en Jesús, más recibiremos.

Este mensaje y devoción a Jesús como La Divina Misericordia se basa en los escritos de Santa Faustina Kowalska, una monja polaca sin educación que, en obediencia a su director espiritual, escribió un diario de 600 páginas que registra las revelaciones que recibió acerca de la misericordia de Dios. Incluso antes de su muerte en 1938, la devoción a La Divina Misericordia había comenzado a extenderse.
