

A conversion is never planned or conceived as a personal project. It is not a prepared item on a life's journey. It may have a time of gestation, but that is difficult to measure. Most souls have no realization until they are near the event itself that they are moving in the direction of a conversion. It is not something ordinarily sought but, rather, seems to seek out a soul. The favor and predilection of God are always behind it. It is as though his eyes linger on certain souls, watching them for a time, before targeting them as a prey of his love.

In truth, therefore, conversions are never entirely sudden, coming out of nowhere, even when they seem to ignite an explosively new force within a life. The hidden chiseling of the hand of God has usually been at work for an unknown time; concealed touches have been laid upon the heart; the trailing of the soul has taken place into its shadowed hours, sometime for long periods of time, even for years. All these preliminary anticipations only point to the essential truth of a serious conversion. God meets a soul at a crossroad of life and in some unexpected way makes his real presence known. A personal encounter with the real mystery of a personal God is at the heart of every conversion.

No es algo que normalmente se busca, sino que parece buscar un alma. El favor y la predilección de Dios siempre están detrás de esto. Es como si sus ojos permanecieran en ciertas almas, observándolas por un tiempo, antes de atacarlas como presas de su amor. En verdad, por lo tanto, las conversiones nunca son completamente repentinas, vienen de la nada, incluso cuando parecen encender una fuerza explosivamente nueva dentro de una vida. El cincelado oculto de la mano de Dios usualmente ha estado trabajando por un tiempo desconocido; toques ocultos han sido puestos sobre el corazón; el arrastre del alma ha tenido lugar en sus horas sombrías, en algún momento durante largos períodos de tiempo, incluso durante años. Todos estos preliminares Las anticipaciones solo apuntan a la verdad esencial de una conversión seria. Dios se encuentra con un alma en una encrucijada de la vida y de alguna manera inesperada da a conocer su presencia real. Un encuentro personal con el verdadero misterio de un Dios personal está en el corazón de cada conversión.




