We can easily take the love of others for granted, whether it be a parent, spouse, friend, or a child. We assume and presume that their love will always be there and do very little to cultivate, rejuvenate, and deepen it. Presumption can become a great sin.

We do the same thing with God and our spiritual lives. We presume that God will be merciful. Because we believe that in the end God is going to forgive us anyway, then why put a lot of effort into things now? What's the point? It's far easier to find a comfortable spot, curl up and take a nap! There is no immediate urgency to staying awake and attentive, so we think, and we simply fly by the seat of our pants.

Folks who are distracted and preoccupied can find their relationships, especially the primary ones, drifting away. You can actually be married to someone for many years and wake up one morning realizing that you really do not know them or truly recognize them. We have to desire God in order to recognize God. We have to open our hearts, minds, and souls to His Presence so that we can be rejuvenated and refreshed. But we cannot do this if we are distracted or napping. We have to be awake and alert! As a young child eagerly watches for and anticipates that arrival of their parent home, so too we must watch for God's presence. If the anticipation of God's arrival does not excite us and rouse us, then we need to ask why. The wise person keeps vigilant watch, knowing that in the end they will not be disappointed.

More Dominicans Campaign 2020:

Did you know that St. Anthony of Padua Church is staffed by Dominican priests? In fact, there are 10 Dominicans (priests & brothers also known as friars) living in the Priory of St. Anthony of Padua. There are four specific aspects (or pillars) that distinguishes the Dominicans from other Roman Catholic religious Order. The second pillar is **STUDY**.

“St. Dominic included study ordained to the ministry of salvation as part of the essential plan for our Order... before all else, our study should aim principally and ardently at this, that we might be able to be useful for the souls of our neighbors”. These words, taken from the Dominican Constitutions clearly illustrate the high value the Order has placed on study. Our student brothers spend at least 5 years in graduate theological studies preparing for full-time ministry. Even after the end of initial formation, a friar’s commitment to study will continue throughout his Dominican life.

On Sunday, November 15, a second collection will be taken to support the continuation of the 800 year legacy of St. Dominic by supporting our young friars in formation. Please prayerfully consider giving your gift.
