THE PASTOR'S CORNER

FINDING THE INFANT CHRIST AT MASS

IN HIS FLOCKNOTE to the Archdiocese last month from Cardinal Dolan, our Archbishop announced an effort by the bishops of the United States to restore belief in what the Church teaches about the Eucharist. The Eucharistic Revival is a three-year plan to help recover belief among Catholics in the Real Presence of Christ in the communion we receive at the Mass. If it is, as the Catechism teaches, the “source and summit” (CCC 1324) this is because our communion with God is the primary aim of our religion and religious practice. Religion is perfect when it offers a real and intimate union between us and our creator. The Church’s understanding that Christ, from his throne in heaven, makes himself (at our beckoning) actually present in what was once bread and wine seems almost too much to be believed. Yet, it is for us the fulfillment of Jesus’ promise at his Ascension to be with us until the end of time.

“I give you praise, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned, you have revealed them to the merest of children.... No one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him,” Jesus prayed (Luke 10:21-24). The prayer gives us a glimpse of the affection between the Father and the Son, and calls us to the same intimacy. It makes one wonder why anyone would forsake such an invitation that is so readily given to us whenever we gather for Mass on Sunday. Unfortunately, the studies agree that all too many Catholics - in their negligence of Mass on Sundays, their disregard of confession and absolution before receiving communion, and their ignorance of the habits of reverence - no longer believe that Jesus is actually present in the Blessed Sacrament.

But this is the very lesson which Christmas shares, the possibility of intimacy with the Lord. If the birth of Jesus is the beginning of our understanding how much God loves us (his Passion and Death being the final argument), so his continued presence in the Holy Eucharist is the same reality the shepherds and the Magi stood at the first Christmas. What they worshipped at the crib, and Mary and John worshipped at the cross, we worship now in his Real Presence. John Saward notes, in his book *Cradle of Redeeming Love*, that before Coptic Christians receive Holy Communion, “they make a confession of faith that identifies the Body in the Sacrament with the Body in the Crib: ‘I believe, I believe, I believe, and confess till my last breath, that this is the life-giving body which thine only-begotten Son, our Lord, God, and Saviour Jesus Christ, took from our Lady, the mistress and queen of all, the holy sinless Virgin Mary, Mother of God.’” (Saward, John, *Cradle of Redeeming Love*, Ignatius Press, 2002). Indeed, Saward goes on to note that Dom Guéranger of the Solesmes Monastery, encouraged priests to kiss the altar as if it were the very crib in which the Son of the Virgin, wrapped in swaddling clothes slept, the “Word who said to men, ‘I am the Bread of Life.’”

In as much as every celebration of the Mass reprises the very Passion of our Lord, making us present before an event that happened 2,000 years ago, also the Nativity - in as much as it was the beginning of salvation - is encompassed in our encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist. A devotion to the Holy Eucharist promises to help us keep Christmas in our hearts all the time (like Scrooge!), and seems like the beginning of a true Eucharistic revival.

READINGS FOR THE SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Reading I – Isaiah 11:1-10

A beautiful description of a future king, who would also be the Messiah. His “knowledge of the Lord” would equip him, so to speak, to bring about a new world of justice and peace.

Reading II – Romans 15:4-9

Paul writes out his thoughts about the encouragement the Holy Scriptures provide to bolster our hope and the willingness to live harmoniously with each other. No longer are the Gentiles excluded from the community.

The Gospel – Matthew 3:1-12

Matthew moves abruptly away from Jesus’ infancy to His adult ministry, with His cousin John the Baptist acting as His precursor. Both John and Jesus relate to each other naturally, but also supernaturally by way of John’s prophetic preaching, poor lifestyle, and practice of baptism. For him, good works flow from true repentance.
