## THE PASTOR'S CORNER

# COME YOU WHO ARE BLESSED...

Then the righteous\* will answer him and say, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?’ And the king will say to them in reply, ‘Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me.’ (Matthew 25:38-40)

**N**OT TOO LONG AGO, our parish mission to extend the love of Jesus Christ as far as we could take it took on a new dimension with a generous grant from the Cabrini Foundation to convert the old convent building into a center for helping the needy of the greater Newburgh area. The parish council agreed that our own experience of Christ would not be as full without trying to find Him in his “least brothers.” Originally, we asked to partner with the Newburgh Ministries in their mission to feed the homeless and desperate poor; support families transitioning from homelessness to permanent

- Prepared over 19,000 meals since 2022
- Held numerous food drives, winter clothing collections, Christmas gift collections, and hygiene product drives
- Donated over 30 bicycles to children who wouldn’t have one otherwise
- Brought new clothing, diapers, high chairs, and other baby products to expectant mothers and their babies in pregnancy care centers
- Supplied furniture, such as beds and bedroom sets, kitchen tables, etc. to formerly homeless families
- Provided these same families with food, hygiene products, paper products and new clothing
- Delivered over 300 Christmas gifts to needy children through the generosity of parishioners and the help of Catholic Charities
- Made 3,120 sandwiches and lunch bags for homeless people at warming stations
- Cooked 104 full trays of baked Ziti and prepared other foods to homeless centers
- Shared food, hygiene and cleaning products, as well as new clothes and toys to Project Life families
- Helped neighboring parish thrift shops in Washingtonville and Monroe with various donated items.

The parish council, with Levon Volpe (chair), John LaGreca, Trish Fleming, Alisha Barnsby, Susan King, and Bob Lynch — and we pray you also — will continue to search for other ways to bring blessings to the parish through service to the poor. We hope to apply again to the Cabrini Foundation this year for

housing through Project Life; and provide help for indigent residents in senior housing.

Our mission has accomplished more than we imagined as we sought to remain open to any possibility that the Holy Spirit presented to us. With thanks to the parish council, John LaGreca and his cadre of volunteers who work from week to week to serve our neighbors, the Knights of Columbus and the Junior Catholic Daughters, parish families and teens, the Presentation Sisters, and many others, may we share with you some of the works you have accomplished:

help with purchasing a delivery van, and will be renaming the outreach building after that other patron of the Churches of St. Thomas of Canterbury and St. Joseph, Saint Marianne Cope, whose own life of service to the needy inspires us.

## THE BOOKS OF THE BIBLE



### II Thessalonians is the 60th book of our Bible.

This second letter to the people of Thessalonica according to the Bible introductory book by our friend, Timothy P. Schehr, finds just as much energy as in I Thessalonians but this time it is Paul's and not the people's. Theirs had waned as the time went on, and Paul here tries to re-motivate them.

When they had heard about the Second Coming of the Lord from Paul earlier, in their understanding of it as being about to happen at any moment, some of them had given up expending energy of any type but rather chose simply to wait for the end's arrival. In this second letter, he counsels that they will experience various

challenges to their beliefs and must be ready to endure hardship because of these. Paul holds himself up as an example for them to follow: He was a hard worker and expects them to be such as well. In this letter (written perhaps a year after the preceding one), we'll hear Paul's opening of thanks for the Thessalonians and their faith, a faith he tries to buoy up for the future (ch. 1), Paul's admonition not to be deceived by alarmists' false prophesying about the end time, and then a word of further thanks (ch. 2), and a plea by Paul for prayers to be preserved from bigoted people, and a call not to be idle (ch. 3).

When you finish this book, you will have read 60 (82.2%) of the 73 books of the Bible, yet 1,264 (94.8%) of the 1,334 chapters of the Bible.

### Reading I – Isaiah 49:3, 5-6

The prophet is also a servant, with God as his strength. His former mission to Jacob and Israel has been changed. Now he is to be a "light to the nations" as well.

### Reading II – I Corinthians 1:1-3

Here is Paul's greeting to the Church in Corinth, which he insists is called to be holy, like all other Christians. He calls for grace to be upon them and the peace of God as well.

### The Gospel – John 1:29-34

John the Baptist offers double testimony to Jesus. He is both the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world, and the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit, who abides in Him.
