JESUS AND THE EUCARIST STUDY



NATIONAL
Eucharistic
Revival

Every parish across the country is invited to host the Jesus and the Eucharist study during the Year of Parish Revival. This series will immerse participants in the kerygmatic proclamation (Videos 1–4) and unveil God's saving work in the Eucharist (Videos 5–7).

Each session opens with an exhortation from a different bishop, followed by lectio divina prayer with scripture. The main lesson is drawn from content created by the Augustine Institute and will include personal testimonies from Catholics across the country. You will be able to access the video from the link (also available on the website). Instructions on which video to watch will be included each week along with reflections and key quotes from the video to reinforce your understanding.

BELOW IS AN OVERVIEW OF EACH SESSION:

Video 1: What's Our Story? The Bible is the story of God's love for us. He created us out of love, redeemed us by his love, and transforms us in his love.

Video 2: Who Is Jesus? Jesus is both God and man, therefore he reveals who God is in relation to us. Jesus asked Simon Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15) He asks this same question of us: who do you say Jesus is?

Video 3: Am I Saved? Salvation is a gift from God through Jesus Christ that requires our "yes."

Video 4: Why a Church? Jesus didn't simply leave us a written message or instruction manual to follow. He gave us a living, dynamic Church where we encounter him personally and allow ourselves to be transformed into his likeness.

Video 5: God Is With Us God's presence in the Old Testament foreshadows the gift of the Eucharist, one of the seven sacraments of the Church. Jesus established the Eucharist to give us strength and accompany us at every moment of our earthly journey.

Video 6: The Story of the Eucharist The story of the Eucharist can be traced throughout Scripture. From Genesis to the present day, this session explores how the Cross is the new Tree of Life, and the Eucharist is its fruit.

Video 7: Bread for the Journey The Eucharist sustains us on our spiritual journey. Our participation at Mass through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist is an offering of thanksgiving to God. We are then sent forth to share what we have received.

We all love a good story—from the characters and the twists and turns of a captivating plot to the dynamics of a conflict and the resolution at the end. The Bible is the story of God’s love for us. It begins with him creating us out of love, redeeming us by that love, and finally transforming us in his love. This divine author is love—an exchange of love within the life of the Blessed Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. What a story!

Some quotes to think about from the video:

1. “*Ta Biblia*” means “the books” in Greek. It’s 73 books in one big story. What story is it?... It’s very simply a love story. *Chris Stefanick*
2. So who is God? The Bible says God is love. *Dr. Edward Sri*
3. God is love... And out of that love comes this creative work which gives life to you and me and to every good gift to which he supplies. *Dr. Sean Innerst*
4. Your life, it’s part of a love story... You are the beloved... An act of love is what brings us from nothingness into existence. *Chris Stefanick*

READINGS FOR THE 29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I — Isaiah 45:1, 4-6

The prophet proclaims Yahweh’s declaration that He is the one Lord, and that there is no other.

Reading II — 1 Thessalonians 1:1-5b

Paul expresses his love for the people and stresses the fact that the power of the gospel comes from the Spirit of God, and not from his rhetoric.

The Gospel — Matthew 22:15-21

To pay taxes meant also to acknowledge that the foreign pagan authority of Rome had authority over Israel. Jesus allows payment of the tax to avoid anarchy. He preferred nonviolent social change that would lead to God’s kingdom.
