

The Miracle at Every Mass

Jesus makes a miracle happen at every Mass so he can be close to me. What can kids do at Mass? So much!




1. GETTING READY

The Church is Jesus' house, and Jesus is my King. When I get ready for Mass, it's nice to dress up because it is so special to be in the King's house. I make sure I am clean and neat when I go to Mass. I especially make sure I brush my teeth!



3. MY GIFT FOR JESUS

After the readings, we pass around a basket to collect gifts for the Church and the poor. Grown-ups usually give money, but Jesus wants something even more special from kids. I think of something I can offer Jesus in my heart and imagine my gift going up to the altar with the bread and wine. God is about to do something really amazing with our gifts.



4. THE MIRACLE

When I hear Jesus' words, "This is my body," a miracle happens! God changes the bread and wine into the real Body and Blood of Jesus. The host still looks like bread, but Jesus is there in disguise.



5. JESUS COMES INTO MY HEART

I fold my hands reverently in the Communion line. When I receive Jesus, I thank him for visiting me in this amazing way. While I wait for everyone else to receive communion, this is the perfect time to have a private conversation with Jesus in my heart.

What Jesus did for us through his Death and Resurrection was the greatest act of love in history. Through this act he saved us. And then, desiring that we encounter him and allowing his Paschal Mystery to reach each of us, he gave us himself in the Eucharist. He did this for each one of us. Individually. But it is easy to feel unworthy of this gift of love. We may feel we have too much baggage. We may feel unlovable. But God didn't come to reveal himself to us on a pedestal; he came to enter into our messy condition, no matter how messy! He came to fix us from within — to transform us from the inside out. Some might be surprised by how generous and abundant the love of God really is. We don't deserve God's love, but that's the incredible reality of God's mercy. This relationship with God isn't all about our love for him. It's about his love for us that changes our lives forever.

But the reality is that in the New Testament, salvation isn't just about what will happen to us after we die — it very much pertains to the here and now as well. In fact, what is it that we need to be saved from: we are enslaved by sin.

READINGS FOR THE 33RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I — Proverbs 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31

This is an acrostic poem, in which each verse begins with a successive letter of the Hebrew alphabet. It cites the woman's extraordinary work including a reach out to the poor and needy.

Reading II — 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6

Thessalonica was a thriving port city. St. Paul reflects on the implications of the Day of the Lord for those alive at that time.

The Gospel — Matthew 25:14-30

The lesson here is the lifestyle a Christian should lead in this interim before Christ returns in glory, which includes a responsible use of the world's goods.
