

CONFIRMATION SERVICE HOURS EXPLANATION

The purpose of service hours is to help the candidate expand their horizon and not limit their ability to see the need of God's people just in their own environment, but to help them understand we are all Creatures made in his likeness and image of God.

The required amount of service is TWENTY (20) hours for the Confirmation Students at SS Peter and Paul, St. Mary's Burnside and St. Patrick Chapel.

THE AMOUNT OF SERVICE IS TO BE DIVIDED UP EVENLY INTO THE THREE AREAS OF:

Church: Handing out bulletins at extraordinary events. Helping the Knights with projects like grave blankets, food boxes, singing in choir, serving during Mass to name a few. As events unfold people will contact the office for help and these needs will be passed on to the parents.

Home: Cleaning, cooking, babysitting, feeding the animals for the family. Doing things without having to be told to do them, out of the ability to see a need, and do an act of service for the family.

Community: Working with community projects like so many to choose from like SCHOOL PROJECTS, COMUNITY PROJECTS like RAKING LEAVES FOR ELDERLY MOWING LAWNS ALL FOR FREE, VISITING THE INFIRM.

At the close of the 7th grade Your Son or Daughter, should have begun serving their hours.

Please keep track of those hours using the reverse side of this form and continue to do so until you have your Interview which will be announced at the beginning of the Catechism School Year.

Please have your hours completed by the Interview which will be in March or April depending on the Date of the Confirmation. You will be turning your hours in to the Teacher, the night of the Confirmation Interviews.
