

St. Joseph's Catholic School is a very important ministry of the Church of St. Joseph. I am very blessed to be part of this parish community as Principal of the school. I would like share with you some reasons why families make the choice to send their children to St. Joseph's School.

First, St. Joseph's School is a safe place that reinforces what parents, the primary educators, teach their children at home. Their children practice and grow in their faith at school through daily faith formation and religious instruction, through prayer and devotions, by attending Mass, visiting the Adoration Chapel, and participating in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program. Our school has the largest and most extensive Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program in the Archdiocese.
