This week we are offered the opportunity to make a choice. We can choose to believe or not the mission of Christ. The Gospel posits three possible life-outcomes: might not perish, might have eternal Life, might be saved. These outcomes are why the Father sent the Son. The Spirit we received last week empowers us to receive God's love, to believe in the Son, and to yearn for eternal Life. We must choose to believe, and do it every day and with everyone we meet. We must truly believe that God the Father loves us and has so much love for us that he sent His Son to show us His love and mercy so that we may believe! His Son shows us the way to the Father if we believe and act on that belief. And the Spirit empowers us to receive and know the love the Father has for us, to believe that Jesus is the way to the Father, and the means of recognizing and the strength to stay on the road that leads to eternal Life.

We are at a time when we truly need to live by faith. Many people in our faith community of St. Pius and in the faith community in our Archdiocese live in fear and insecurity. Many go to work on the hope and prayer that they come back to their families because of the rumors of neighbors being picked up and families left without support, without a parent, without a home, all because of fear. Fear of a language we don't know, fear of customs that seem strange, or perhaps fear that if we let them come in or stay, they will take over. What will happen to us....

Our Church and our Lord call us to stand by faith each day! God loves us so much that we will have all that we need! He loves us so much that we are told to sell everything and give it to the poor because when we are empty we become totally aware of His presence in our lives! He loves us so much that when we give of ourselves, and carry our Cross, we will have eternal Life!

Thank you for sharing your gifts with the poor and giving to the Pantry! For this, a hundredfold is coming to you and your family!

We are inviting the presenters from Catholic Charities to come and speak to all of us on the issue of immigration and human rights. They will be at our **Church Cafeteria on Monday, June 26, 2017, at 7PM**. Come and be informed! Come and show your support to all those that have no voice and are just trying to keep their families safe, together, and working to have the basic human needs.
