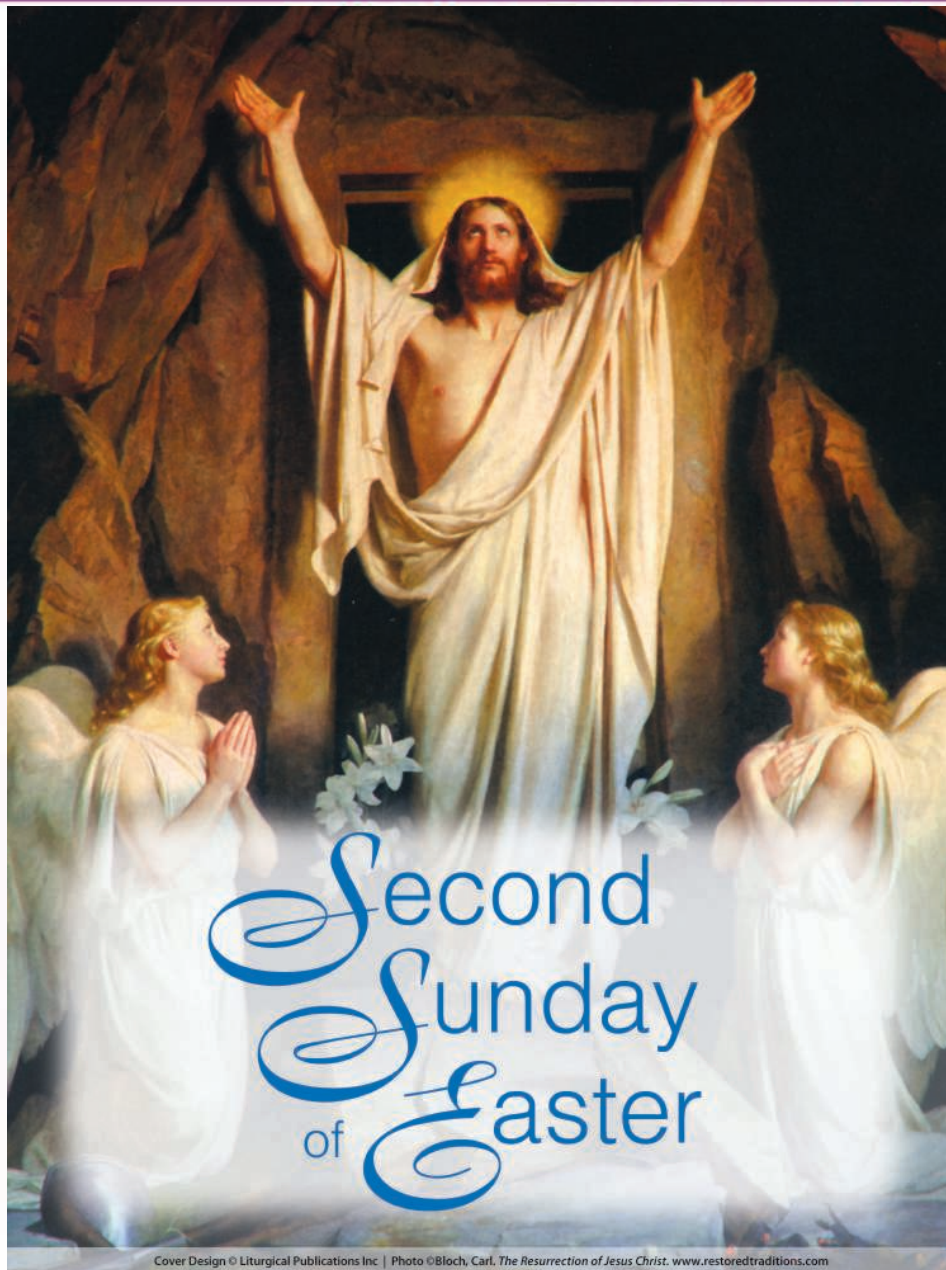

2015 Wisconsin Geographic Bee

Alex Sarandos, St. Paul School 8th grader, was one of 123 students from the state to participate in the 2015 Wisconsin Geographic Bee sponsored by the National Geographic Society and Plum Creek held in Madison on Friday, March 27. Approximately 9,531 students from across the state took part in local bees. As St. Paul School Geo Bee winner, Alex had to take a written test that was sent to the National Geographic Society in Washington D.C. to determine if he qualified for the state level. At state, Alex tied for 12th place. This was the second year in a row that Alex won the school level and qualified for the state level. He is also the only student in St. Paul School's fifty year history to make it to the state level.



2015 Badger State Spelling Bee

Jacqui Wittmann, St. Paul School 8th grader, was one of 47 students from the state to participate in the 2015 Badger State Spelling Bee sponsored by the Wisconsin State Journal held Saturday, March 28. Approximately 91,136 students across the state participated in local level bees with only 47 moving on to the state level from the twelve CESA districts.

Jacqui was the only student representing the entire Lake Country area at the state bee. Jacqui tied for 12th place out of the 47 students. She is only the second St. Paul student in its fifty year history to qualify for state.

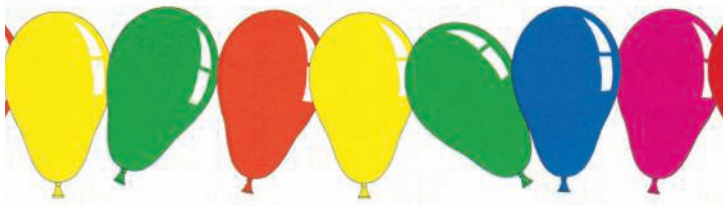


2014 Tax Break

The Wisconsin Council of Religious and Independent Schools is reminding Catholic school families about a new tuition tax deduction that will provide tax relief to Wisconsin taxpayers. Under the new deduction, taxpayers can subtract eligible private school tuition and book fees from their income. It allows up to \$4,000 per pupil in grades K-8, and up to \$10,000 per pupil in grades 9-12. The tax deduction was adopted by the legislature as part of its 2013-15 state budget. Taxpayers can take advantage of it for the first time this year when filing their 2014 taxes, which are due April 15. Visit www.revenue.wi.gov/forms/2014/form1_inst.pdf for additional information.
